



**BUSINESS ENTERPRISE PROGRAM
NO CHANGE APPLICATION CERTIFICATION CHECKLIST**

The annual certification renewal process is a crucial part of your yearly profile review. The No Change Application (NCA) verifies your ownership and control have remained unchanged since the last certification, ensuring the validity of your Business Enterprise Program certification. Your active participation in this process is both appreciated and essential.

Each applicant business is required to submit:

- BEP application affidavit signed by an authorized officer of the firm and notarized.
- Current Federal Income Taxes with all schedules and attachments, including affiliate business income taxes.
- Current license(s) (local, county, and state business license(s), permit(s), and professional license(s) (e.g., contractor, architect, or engineer's registration as required by law)).

No Change certification is valid for one year and is reviewed annually.

If necessary, applicants may be asked to supply other documentation, including the prior year's income tax information. Failure to provide requested documents may result in a delay or denial of your certification renewal.
