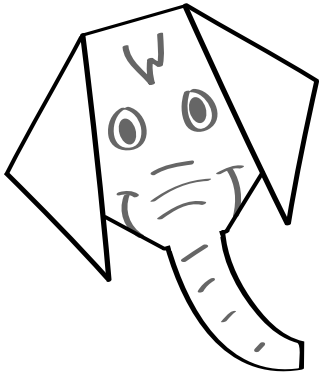


# Origami

When Toot traveled to Japan he learned how to fold paper into shapes like animals and flowers.

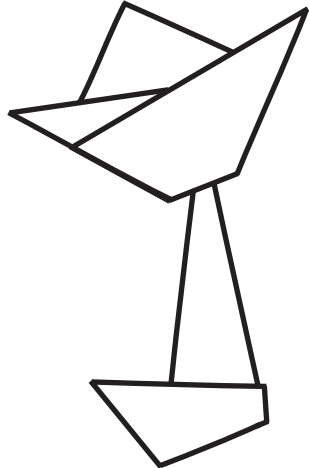
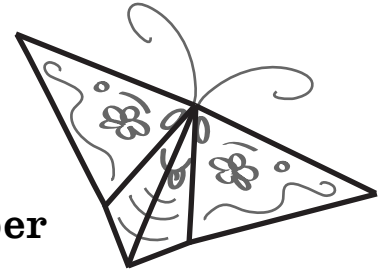


## You Will Need:

**Have an origami party! Make a bunch as decorations and give everyone supplies to fold their own.**

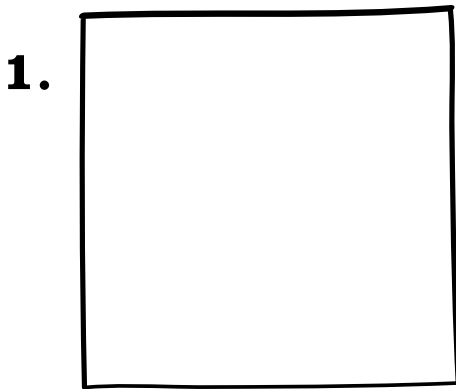

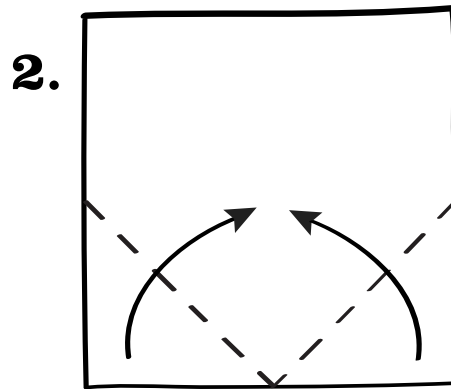

# Origami Cat or Pig

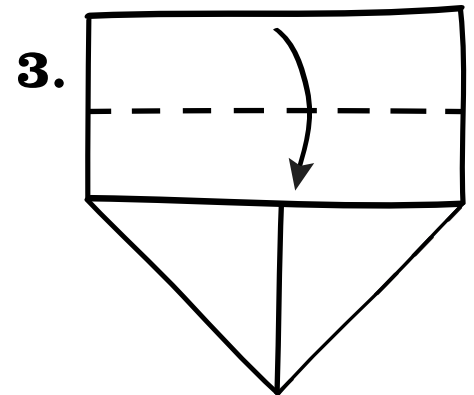
Toot and Puddle have made friends all over the world.  
Create your own origami animal friends.



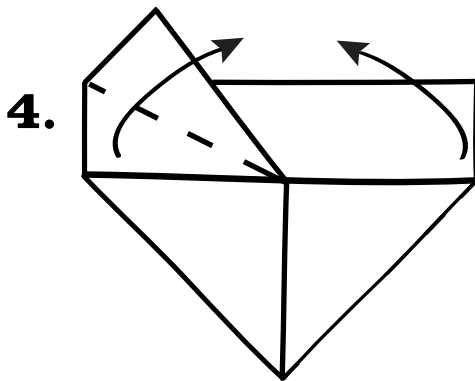
Start with a square of paper.



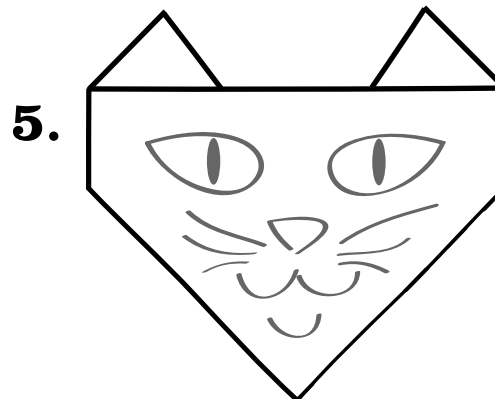
Fold the bottom corners to the center.



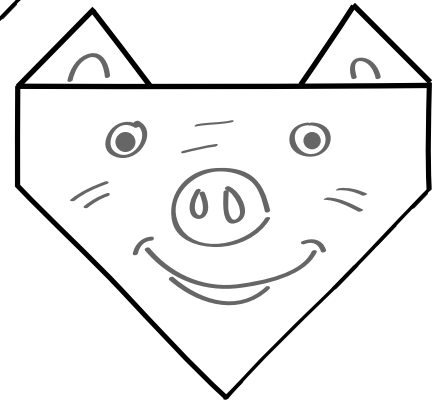
Fold the top half down to the center.

Turn over and draw a cat or pig face.



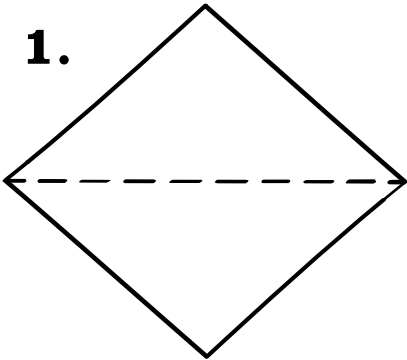
Can you think of another animal face to draw? Try that.



# Origami Dog or Elephant

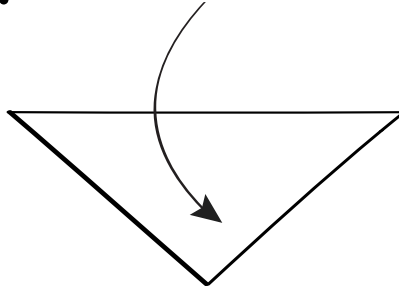
Toot and Puddle have made friends all over the world.

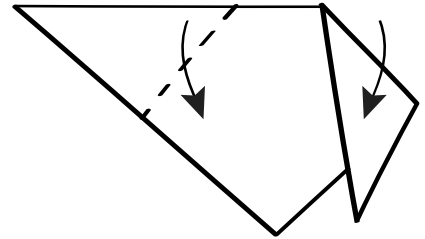
Start with a square of paper

2.



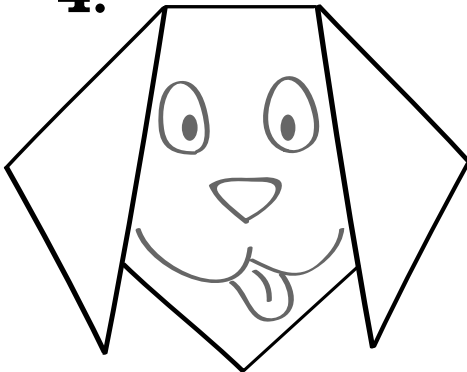
Fold the square in half to make a triangle.

3.



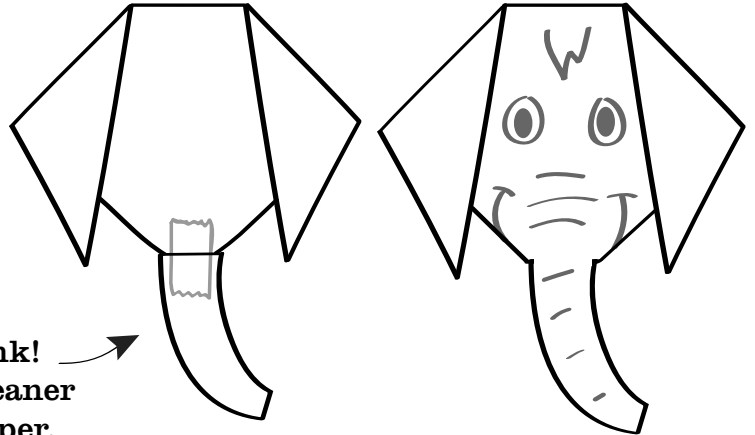
Fold the points down to make elephant ears!

Can you think of another animal face to draw? Try that.

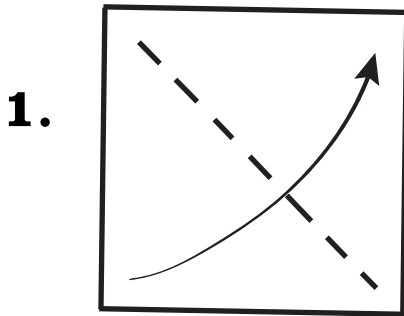

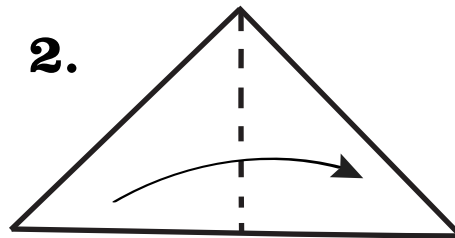

# Origami Butterfly

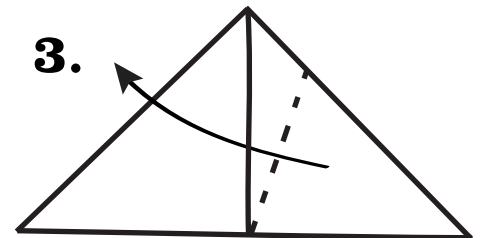
Toot and Puddle's garden is visited by beautiful butterflies. Make some and bring the outdoors inside.



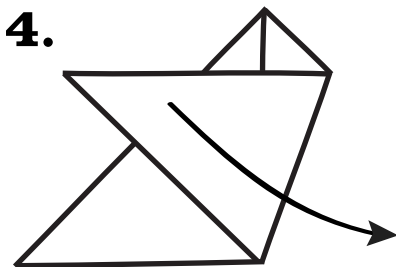
Fold the paper in half diagonally.



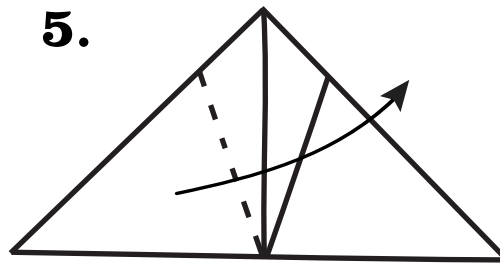
Fold and unfold along the center to crease.



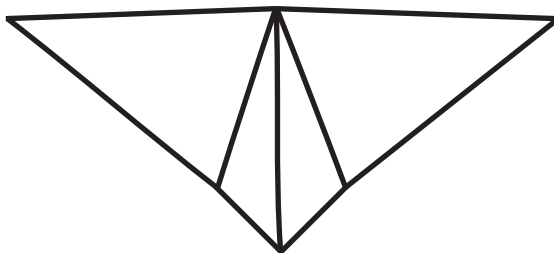
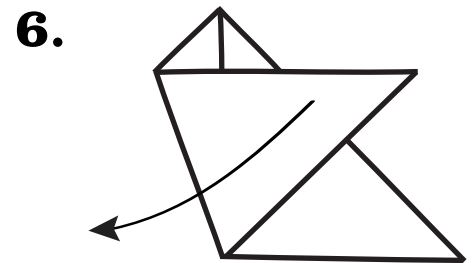
Fold the right corner up over the left side.



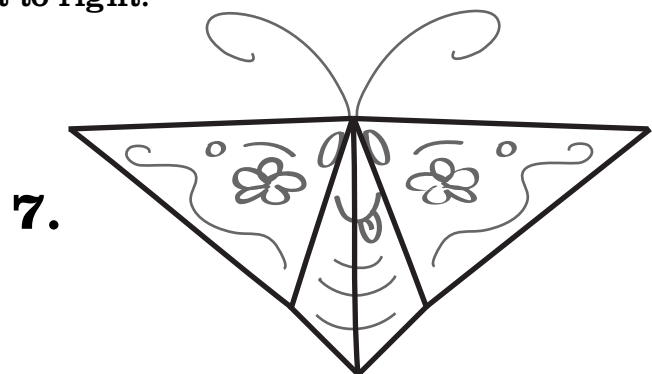
Unfold leaving crease.



Repeat fold and unfold from left to right.



Your butterfly now has flappable wings.

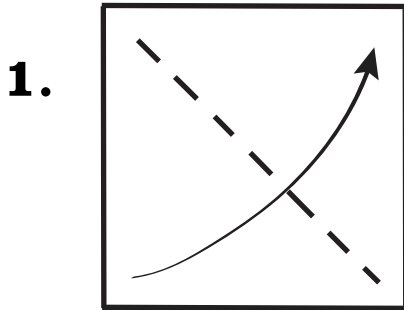


Color and decorate both sides of the butterfly.

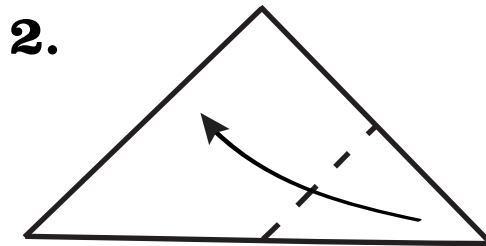


# Origami Tulip

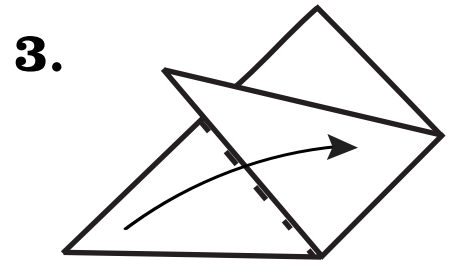
Toot traveled to Holland to bring back tulips for his friend Tulip. You can make your own at home. You will need two pieces of paper.



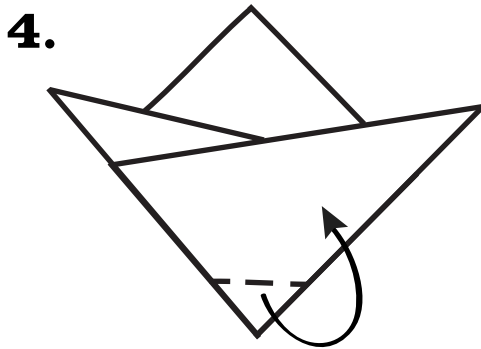
Fold the paper in half diagonally.



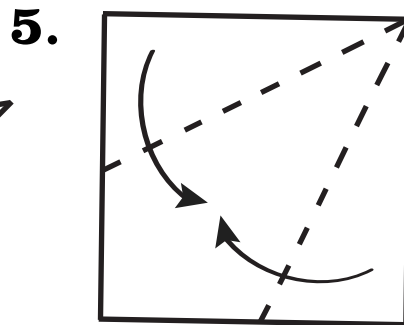
Fold the right corner over the left side.



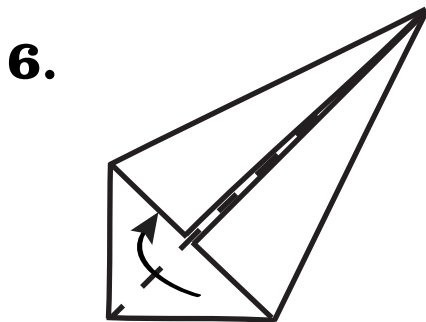
Fold the left corner over the right side.



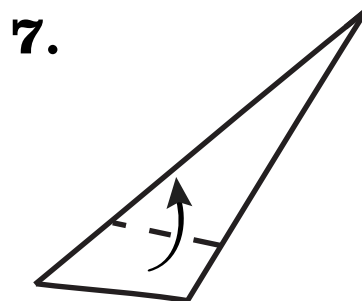
Fold up the bottom of the flower.



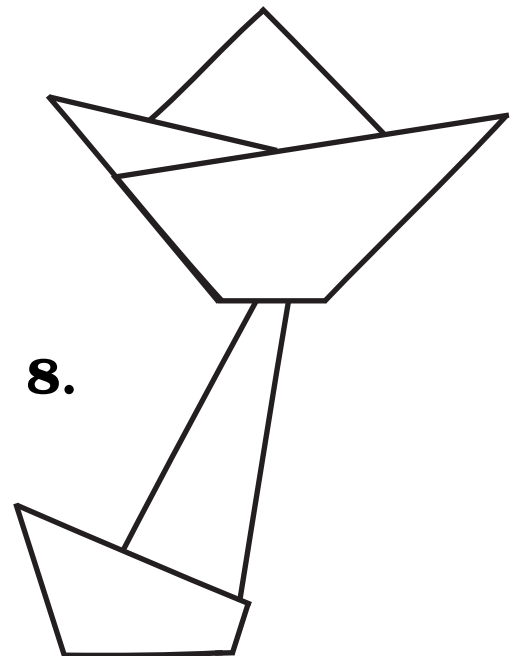
Fold in two corners of a second piece of paper.



Fold the flaps in on themselves.



Fold up the bottom to make the leaf.



Put both pieces together and color.
