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

From 2005 to 2006:

- ❑ The **violent crime rate** increased 1.2 percent.
- ❑ The **property crime rate** decreased 3.2 percent.

Crime in California, 2006, Advance Release is published by the Department of Justice to provide annual 2006 criminal justice data as soon as possible. Information about crimes, arrests, adult felony arrest dispositions, and juvenile justice is included. This report compares crime and arrest rates from 2005 to 2006, and from 1989 to 2006.

Violent crime rates for 1992 and 2006 are also compared since 1992 marked a high point for the period shown. Property crime rates for 1989 and 2006 are compared

since 1989 marked a peak for the period shown. (Note that larceny-theft over \$400 was added to the property crime category in 2003 to give a more representative depiction of crime in California and to correlate more closely to national data presentation. These data are only available since 1983, hence the period presented in this report.)

The more extensive reports, *Crime in California, 2006* and *Juvenile Justice in California, 2006*, will be published later this year.

From 2005 to 2006:

- ◆ The violent crime rate increased 1.2 percent. The violent crime rate has decreased 53.0 percent since its peak in 1992.
- ◆ The property crime rate decreased 3.2 percent. The property crime rate has decreased 43.3 percent since its peak in 1989.

From 2005 to 2006:

- ◆ Total arrests increased 0.6 percent in rate per 100,000 population at risk. Total arrests have decreased 39.8 percent in rate since 1989.
- ◆ Felony arrests decreased 2.1 percent in rate per 100,000 population at risk. Felony arrests have decreased 30.2 percent in rate since 1989.
- ◆ Misdemeanor arrests increased 1.6 percent in rate. Misdemeanor arrests have decreased 45.0 percent in rate since 1989.

As a percentage of reported adult felony arrest dispositions:

- ◆ Law enforcement releases decreased from 3.2 percent in 2005 to 2.8 percent in 2006.
- ◆ Total complaints denied increased from 12.2 percent in 2005 to 13.3 percent in 2006.
- ◆ Dismissals and acquittals increased from 13.7 percent in 2005 to 14.6 percent in 2006.
- ◆ Convictions decreased from 71.0 percent in 2005 to 69.3 percent in 2006.

- ◆ Juveniles made a ward of the court decreased from 37.6 percent in 2002 to 31.1 percent in 2006.
- ◆ Juveniles committed to the youth authority decreased from 0.7 percent in 2002 to 0.3 percent in 2006.
