Crime Down in California

The number of crimes reported for 2009 declined in every offense category when compared to 2008

Violent and Property Crimes, January through December 2009

Preliminary crime statistics show that violent crimes reported for 2009 decreased 8.5 percent from 2008 (from 129,046 to 118,134). Property crimes decreased 11.1 percent (from 413,661 to 367,745). The violent crime categories include homicide, forcible rape, robbery, and aggravated assault. The property crime categories include burglary, motor vehicle theft, and larceny-theft over \$400. (For crime category definitions see *Crime in California* at <http://ag.ca.gov/cjsc/pubs.php>.)

The following is a breakdown of each crime category for 2009:

- **Homicide** – The number of homicides decreased 10.5 percent from 1,643 to 1,470. Thirty-three agencies reported increases while the remaining 53 agencies stayed the same or decreased. This resulted in a net decrease of 173 homicides.
- **Forcible Rape** – The number of forcible rapes decreased 2.9 percent from 5,654 to 5,490. Forty-two agencies reported increases while the remaining 44 agencies stayed the same or decreased. This resulted in a net decrease of 164 forcible rapes.
- **Robbery** – The number of robberies decreased 10.5 percent from 51,646 to 46,203. Fifty-three agencies stayed the same or decreased while the remaining 33 agencies reported increases. This resulted in a net decrease of 5,443 robberies.
- **Aggravated Assault** – The number of aggravated assaults decreased 7.3 percent from 70,103 to 64,971. Fifty-three agencies stayed the same or decreased while the remaining 33 agencies reported an increase. This resulted in a net decrease of 5,132 aggravated assaults.
- **Burglary** – The number of burglaries decreased 5.0 percent from 147,101 to 139,703. Fifty-seven agencies stayed the same or decreased while the remaining 29 agencies reported an increase. This resulted in a net decrease of 7,398 burglaries.
- **Motor Vehicle Theft** – The number of motor vehicle thefts decreased 17.4 percent from 126,739 to 104,742. Seventy-one agencies stayed the same or decreased while the remaining 15 agencies reported an increase.

This resulted in a net decrease of 21,997 motor vehicle thefts.

- **Larceny-theft over \$400** – The number of larceny-thefts over \$400 decreased 11.8 percent from 139,821 to 123,300. Fourteen agencies reported increases while the remaining 72 agencies stayed the same or decreased. This resulted in a net decrease of 16,521 larceny-thefts over \$400.

Preliminary Crime Data

This report compares California preliminary crime counts for January through December 2009 with final counts for the same period in 2008. Statistics were extracted for 87 agencies serving populations of 100,000 or more. Those 87 jurisdictions account for approximately 64 percent of the crimes reported annually in the

state, and provide an early indication of the crime picture for the current year. One agency was unable to provide an entire 12 months of data. To maintain comparability of the 2009 data with the 2008 data, the available statistics for this agency are provided, but not included in the analysis of the data.

The law enforcement jurisdictions are grouped into three categories: police departments that provide law enforcement services to cities, sheriff's departments that provide services to unincorporated areas, and contract cities that contract for service rather than maintain their own police force.

The 2009 crime data used in this report are preliminary and subject to change.
