### **Crime Down in California**

*The number of violent crimes reported for 2010 decreased 6.4 percent when compared to 2009; property crimes declined 2.2 percent.*

#### **Preliminary Crime Data**

The following tables compare California preliminary crime counts for January through December 2010 with final counts for the same period in 2009. Statistics were extracted for 89 agencies serving populations of 100,000 or more. Those 89 jurisdictions account for approximately 65 percent of the crimes reported annually in the state and provide an early indication of the crime picture for the current year.

The law enforcement jurisdictions are grouped into three categories: police departments that provide law enforcement services to cities, sheriff's departments that provide services to unincorporated areas, and contract cities that contract for service rather than maintain their own police force.

The 2010 crime data used in this report are preliminary and subject to change.
