CBFS is excited to announce the Mortgage Banking Certificate program, created in association with Star One Credit Union. The certificate is a (non-credit) program that exposes participants to residential real estate mortgage analysis, underwriting and approval.

The Mortgage Banking Certificate is taught by Star One's managers and executives and is organized in three 90-minute sessions, with a final team-competition where the best performing team is rewarded with scholarships. In addition to the technical skills acquired in the program, participants learn about careers in banking and benefit from valuable networking opportunities.

Equity Competition and Conference

The SJSU Equity Competition and Conference is the new program organized by CBFS, the Banking and Investment Association and the Silicon Valley Aggressive Growth Fund at SJSU.

The Equity Competition is a (non-credit) program that exposes participants to equity research, valuation and decision making (buy, hold or sell). The equity competition participants are mentored for up to 2 hours by investments and valuation professionals, with a final team-competition where the best performing team is awarded a trophy. In addition to the technical skills acquired in the program, participants learn about careers in investments through valuable networking opportunities.
