BODYNAMIC WINE: WINE GROWN UNDER THE PRINCIPLES DICTATED BY THE AUSTRIAN RUDOLF STEINER IN 1920, PROMOTES THE USE OF NATURAL PREPARATIONS TO HELP PLANTS DEVELOP HEALTHY IMMUNE SYSTEM, IT ALSO ENCOURAGE POLY CULTURE AND BIODIVERSITY IN THE VINEYARD

ORGANIC WINE: WINES MADE FROM GRAPES GROWN WITHOUT ARTIFICIAL FERTILISERS, WEED KILLERS, FUNGICIDES OR PESTICIDES. THEY CAN PROTECT THE GRAPES WITH COPPER, SULPHUR DIOXIDE (SO2) AND VINE TREATMENT MADE FROM VEGETABLES AND MINERAL EXTRACT.



NATURAL WINE: MADE WITHOUT CHEMICAL FERTILISERS OR PESTICIDES IN THE FIELD AND NO FILTRATION, ADDED YEAST, ENZYMES AND VERY LITTLE ADDED SULPHUR.

ORANGE/AMBER WINE: THEY USE THE OLDEST KNOWN METHOD OF PRODUCTION, WHICH GIVES A BUILT-IN PROTECTION TO THE WINES. MADE BY LEAVING WHITE GRAPES IN CONTACT WITH THEIR SKINS (AND SOMETIMES SEEDS AND STALKS) FOR AN EXTENDED PERIOD OF TIME. IT CAN BE SAID THAT THEY ARE WHITE WINES MADE LIKE RED WINES.

First created for Count Camillo Negroni in 1919 at Florence's Café Cesconi, the Negroni cocktail was actually predated by the Milano-Torino, a mix of bitter, Barry Campari and sweet vermouth that evolved into the Americano with the addition of soda water. Legend has it that around 1920, at the Count's favourite Florentine bar, he requested something stronger; the soda was replaced with Gin, and the Negroni Cocktail was born.

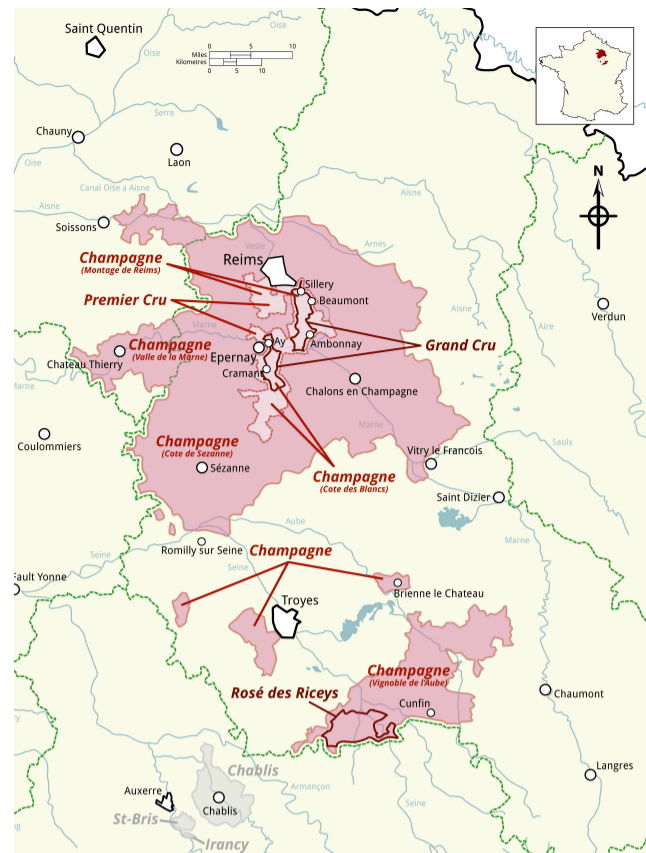

Grower Champagnes or Artisan Champagnes: are Champagnes produced by the estate that owns the vineyards where the grapes are grown. Récoltant-Manipulant is the term in French, and Grower Champagnes can be identified by "RM" on the wine label.

While large Champagne houses such as Mumm, Moët et Chandon and Veuve Clicquot may use grapes from as many as 80 different vineyards in the Champagne region to create a consistent house style, Grower Champagnes tend to be more terroir-focused, sourced from a single vineyard or closely located vineyards around a village, and made with grapes which vary with each vintage. Today there are over 19,000 independent growers in the Champagne region, accounting for nearly 88% of vineyard land in the region; around 5,000 of these growers produce wine from their own grapes. Of the Champagne imported into the US in 2014, only 5% was Grower Champagne.

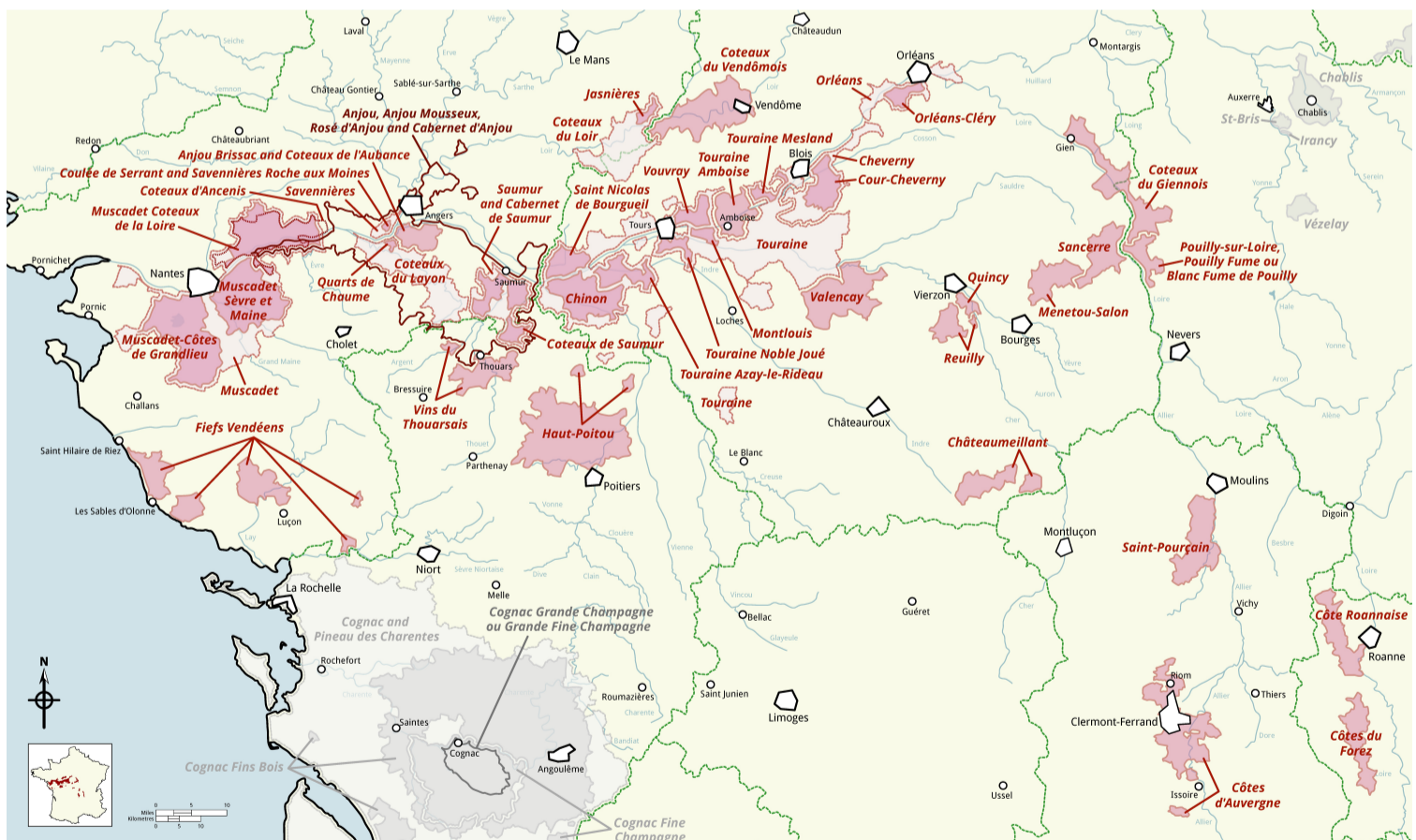

Having worked at Coche-Dury, with Gérard Chave in Hermitage, and Eloi Dürrbach at Domaine Trévallon in Provence, Laurent Vaillé had the pedigree to head out on his own. He sourced cuttings from the latter two producers, and in 1989 planted 9 hectares of red grapes, with just a single hectare of white grapes, on a hillside just down the road from Mas du Daumas Gassac. Here, he worked the vineyards according to organic and biodynamic principles, without being certified, and made a single red from Syrah and Mourvèdre, with smaller proportions of Cabernet Sauvignon and Counoise, and a single white from Roussanne, Marsanne and Chardonnay. Laurent passed away at the age of 57 in 2021. Already incredibly sought after, his final vintages have become like gold dust.

Aging Barolo in French barrels was the first innovation brought to Piedmont by Elio Altare and his friends – known as the "Barolo Boys".

The "Barolo Boys" were a group of Italian winemakers in the Barolo region who, beginning in the late 1950s, revolutionized the area's winemaking methods and culture. They worked to make Barolo less tannic and more approachable, using new methods like reducing the number of grapes harvested and using a new type of barrel.

Known as barrique, the new barrel only contained 225 liters, and was much smaller than traditional ones, resulting in having more liquid in contact with the inner surface of the barrel itself. Consequently, the wine would absorb more flavors from the toasted French oak and the tannin of the Nebbiolo grapes would evolve more easily.

Their passion for creating the best expression of Nebbiolo defined the style of modern Barolo that is well-known today.

In Italy, Barolo is revered as the King of Wines... and the Wine of Kings



Named after the original founders of the estate, the Avignonesi family, the winery has undergone an exciting journey. Acquired by Virginie Saverys in 2009, Avignonesi has grown in size and become a leader in biodynamic viticulture in Italy. Since the acquisition and Virginie's respect for the ecosystem the winery has started producing and crafting organic wines that are truly authentic, true to their origins yet singular and unique; with the best biodynamic approach. Their wines receive minimal intervention in the cellar! Sustainability also plays a big part in the everyday life at Avignonesi.

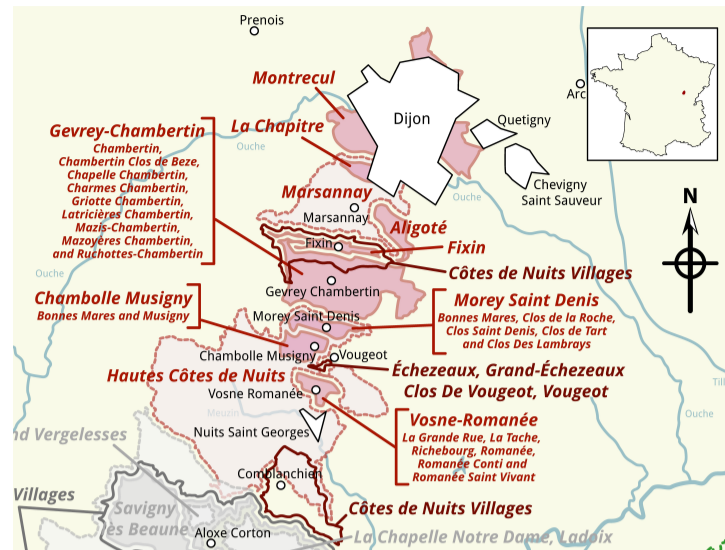
