

Southwest Land Border Encounters

The goal of this data dictionary is to provide insight into how users should read and analyze the raw data available for download.

I. Tips when working with Encounter data:

- 1. Statistical information is subject to change due to corrections, systems changes, change in data definition, additional information, or encounters pending final review.
- 2. The data represents encounters at the Southwest Land Border (e.g., U.S. Border Patrol [USBP] Sector, Office of Field Operations [OFO] Field Office); it is not available at the level of individual areas of responsibility (AOR), ports of entry (POE), stations, etc.

1. Data Source: Secure Government Integrated Mainframe Access (SIGMA), Unified Secondary (USEC); Enforcement Integrated Database (EID)

¹ Accompanied Minor represents a child accompanied by a parent or legal guardian and the parent or legal guardian is either a U.S. Citizen, Lawful Permanent Resident, or admissible noncitizen, and the child is determined to be inadmissible. Accompanied minors is a demographic used only by OFO.

² FMUA represents the number of encountered individuals within the family unit, not the number of units. A Family Unit is defined as a least one noncitizen minor child and at least one noncitizen adult parent or legal guardian. For example, a family unit consisting of two or more individuals is encountered. The data would show two or more individuals, not one family unit. Beginning in March 2020, FMUA data also includes Title 42 Expulsions of a family group of at least one child and one related adult (regardless of whether the adult and child met the definition of a family unit).
