<input type="checkbox"/>	1	Ready Reserve (including IMA, IRR, Navy Reserve, and Selected Reserve) – Actively participating in a unit
<input type="checkbox"/>	2	Standby Reserve – Reservist within reserve system but no participation in a unit

<input type="checkbox"/>	4	Retired Military – Regular

Definitions for USS Code/Service Type:

- *0-None* if you are not currently active in the Reserves/National Guard.
- *1-Ready Reserve* if you are considered a military Reservist and actively participate in a unit. This includes IMA, IRR, Navy Reserve, and Selected Reserve categories.
- *2-Standby Reserve* if you are considered a military Reservist but do not participate in a unit.
- *3-National Guard* if you are currently active in the National Guard.
- *4-Retired Military Regular* if you are retired from a Regular military unit (i.e. not the Reserves).
- *5-Retired Military Non-Regular* if you retired from the military as a Non-Regular retiree (i.e. retirement from Reserves is considered Non-Regular retirement.)
- *6-Retired Military Regular and Reserve/National Guard* if you are a Regular Retiree (i.e. not the Reserves) and are currently active in the Reserves /National Guard.
- *7-Retired Military Non-Regular and Reserve/National Guard* if you retired from a Non-Regular military unit (i.e. Reserves) and are currently active in the Reserves/National Guard.
- *8-Retired Military and DC National Guard* if you retired from the military (i.e. Regular or Reserves) and are currently active in the DC National Guard.
- *9-DC National Guard* if you are currently active in the DC National Guard.
