Cardholders can access up to \$1,000 daily in cash advances, subject to available credit and available cash, at any CIBC ATM or any of the nearly one million ATMs displaying the Visa, *Interac*® or Plus* System symbols. All you need is your card and your PIN.¹⁴

Card Replacement and up to \$5,000 emergency cash advance¹³

Whether you're working at home or abroad, if a card is lost or stolen, or if any cardholder suspects someone is using their card or card number, contact CIBC Telephone Banking, CIBC Credit Card Services, or a CIBC Banking Centre as soon as possible.

You will have access to an emergency replacement card and up to \$5,000 in emergency cash advances.

Cardholder Spending Limits¹⁵

Notes, trademarks and disclaimers

- ¹ CIBC Rewards Program clients may “transfer,” which means move, the Aventura points earned from eligible Aventura credit card accounts, where they are the Primary Cardholder or Rewards Officer. Transferring Points can be done between Aventura credit cards through cibcrewards.com or by calling the CIBC Rewards Centre at 1 888 232-5656. Authorized Users and Delegates cannot perform points transfer transactions, but will be able to view any points transfer activity on the Primary Cardholder’s or Rewards Officer’s account in their account history. Points entered must be positive and within the minimum of 1 and the maximum of total points available in the account, at the time of performing points transfers. The Credit Card Accounts that you wish to transfer points between must be in good standing.
- ² Aventura Points will be cancelled if they remain unredeemed for 60 days after you voluntarily close your Aventura credit card account. If the Rewards Officer dies or is removed by the Business, all Aventura Points in the Aventura Account and all Aventura Points earned after the date of death or removal will automatically be transferred to the new Rewards Officer appointed by the Business as of the date of death or removal. The old Rewards Officer and/or his or her estate shall have no vested rights in the Aventura Points and will not be entitled to any compensation in respect of the transfer.
- ³ Only the Rewards Officer is permitted to perform a “Payment with Points” or “Financial Product with Points” redemption. Other Cardholders are not eligible. Redemptions are non-refundable, non-exchangeable and non-transferable unless you are advised otherwise. Requested redemption amount must be equal to or less than the available points balance.
