2. **General objective**

The general objective is to ensure compliance with the requirements of Commission Implementing Decision 2013/305/EU, Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) No 1396/2014 and Regulation (EU) 2016/1139, by means of a coordinated programme of inspections of fishing vessels at sea and in ports of landing.

3. **Summary of activity**

a) Inspections ashore

During this joint campaign period 1.756 individuals of SAL and 2.823 t of COD, 21.302 t HER and 36.488 t SPR were inspected at landing. In total, there were 2.671 inspections carried out ashore with 85 suspected infringements reported.

b) Inspections at sea

During this joint campaign period 1.138 individuals of SAL and 543 t of COD, 1.965 t HER and 4.627 t SPR species were monitored at sea. In total, there were 806 inspections carried out at sea with 32 suspected infringements reported.
