

Executive Board meeting 29 August 2022 Summary of outcomes

The Chair of the Executive Board, Mr Ladislav Hamran, opened the meeting and welcomed the members to the nineteenth meeting in 2022 of the Executive Board of Eurojust.

Main decisions

The Executive Board adopted the Executive Board Decision empowering the Administrative Director to request the Commission's agreement pursuant to Article 110(2) of the Staff Regulations on the non-application by analogy of Commission Decision C(2022) 1788 of 24 March 2022 laying down general implementing provisions on working time and hybrid working.

The Executive Board discussed the framework for a more structured and systematic cross-checking of data with Europol on a hit/no hit basis and the related internal workflows.

The Executive Board decided to accept the request to participate in the FRA study 'Violence and related human rights abuses against women fleeing the war in Ukraine'.

The Executive Board decided to accept the request to participate in the UNODC study 'Environmental crime and climate change'.
