## MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN

This memorandum records the intention of IFSC – FEDERAL INSTITUTE OF EDUCATION, SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY IN SANTA CATARINA, BRAZIL (Av. Mauro Ramos, 950, Florianópolis – SC- Brasil, CEP 88.103-435) AND UNIVERSITY OF MARIBOR, SLOVENIA, (Slomskov trg 15, 2000 Maribor) to strengthen ties between the two institutions which might lead in future to the establishment of one or more partnership agreements for exchange purposes, academic co-operation or research interests.

At present, this agreement is made as a gesture of goodwill between the two institutions which may see the development of links in the areas of:

- a) Learning and teaching including the development of special programmes
- b) Exchanges of students for a given period through a recognised exchange programme

This agreement is subject to revision, renewal or cancellation by mutual consent and becomes effective upon completion of signature.
