TWENTY-THIRD EXTENSION OF STATE OF LOCAL EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Florida Governor Ron DeSantis in accordance with Article IV Section (1)(a) of the Florida Constitution and Chapter 252, Florida Statutes, promulgated Emergency Order 20-52 to declare a state of emergency in the State of Florida in response to Novel Coronavirus ("COVID-19"); and

WHEREAS, Florida Governor Ron DeSantis, in accordance with Article IV, Section 1(a) of the Florida Constitution and Chapter 252, Florida Statutes, promulgated Executive Order 20-114 and Executive Order 20-166 to extend Executive Order 20-52 for additional sixty (60) day periods; and

WHEREAS, on March 12, 2020, City of Miami Mayor Francis X. Suarez declared a State of Local Emergency in response to COVID-19 in and for the City of Miami, Florida; and


WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 252.38(3)(a), Florida Statutes, the duration of each state of emergency declared locally is limited to 7 days and may be extended, as necessary, in 7-day increments; and

WHEREAS, on March 17, 2020, March 24, 2020, March 31, 2020, April 7, 2020, and April 14, 2020, April 21, 2020, April 28, 2020, May 5, 2020, May 12, 2020, May 19, 2020, May 26, 2020, June 2, 2020, June 9, 2020, June 16, 2020, June 23, 2020, June 30, 2020, July 7, 2020, July 14, 2020, July 21, 2020, July 28, 2020, August 4, 2020, and August 11, 2020, City of Miami Mayor Francis X. Suarez declared extensions to the State of Local Emergency in response to COVID-19 in and for the City of Miami, Florida; and


WHEREAS, despite previous emergency measures the effects of COVID-19 continue to require extraordinary and immediate actions by the City of Miami in order to protect the public health, safety, and welfare; and

NOW THEREFORE, as **Mayor** of the City of Miami and pursuant to the authority vested in the Office of the Mayor by virtue of Section 4(g)(3), of the City Charter, and pursuant to Home Rule Powers under Article VIII, Section 2(b) of the Florida Constitution, Section 166.021, Florida Statutes, and Sections 252.31 - 252.60, Florida Statutes, I hereby declare an extension to the State of Local Emergency. This Twenty-third Extension of State of Local Emergency includes all of the City of Miami.

Pursuant to this Declaration, the City Manager is hereby ordered to take whatever prudent actions are necessary to protect the health, safety, and welfare of the community.

NOTICE OF TWENTY-THIRD EXTENSION TO THE STATE OF LOCAL EMERGENCY IN THE CITY OF MIAMI, FLORIDA

Under the provisions of law and §252.38(3)(a)(5), Florida Statutes, the Mayor of the City of Miami, Francis X. Suarez, has, on August 18, 2020, at 6:26 am, extended the State of Local Emergency within the City of Miami, Miami-Dade County, Florida.

All persons within the said City are advised to become informed as to the contents of the above Twenty-third Extension of a State of Local Emergency and to keep informed as to the provisions of the Local Supplementary Emergency Orders. Violations of the Local Emergency Orders or the Local Supplementary Emergency Orders will subject persons to arrest and upon conviction thereof to the penalties as provided by law.
