PARK WELLSTATE Makuhari Bay-Park (total 617 units) to open on September 1, 2024

Tokyo, Japan, August 29, 2024 – Mitsui Fudosan Residential Co., Ltd., a leading housing company headquartered in Tokyo, announced today that PARK WELLSTATE Makuhari Bay-Park ("the property"), the largest of the PARK WELLSTATE series of senior residences, will open in Mihama-ku, Chiba City, Chiba Prefecture on September 1, 2024. PARK WELLSTATE is a serviced senior residence*2 that enables independent, healthy seniors to thrive and flourish in a new stage of their lives, in an age when more and more people are likely to live to 100. PARK WELLSTATE properties prioritize health and security, featuring design that fits the culture and character of the area, and provide a broad range of services and activities. A TV commercial starring Sayuri Yoshinaga with the message "My favorite time is always right now" began airing in August 2024, which has been well received.

PARK WELLSTATE Makuhari Bay-Park will open in Makuhari Bay-Park, a large-scale neighborhood creation project in Makuhari New City, which has diverse commercial facilities. Conveniently located only 29 minutes from Tokyo Station, the area offers abundant natural features such as the coastline and spacious park right by the city. The property will be one of the largest serviced senior residences in Kanto area*1 in terms of the number of units. Designed with the concept of "enjoying human connections and close relationship with nature – a senior residence open to the sky, earth, city, and people," PARK WELLSTATE Makuhari Bay-Park has 2,400 large and medium-height trees planted in the grounds, which is the greatest number of trees in the whole series. This means that residents can enjoy abundant greenery and the changing seasons without leaving the property. It has three courtyards and a roof garden, offering open views of water and plants everywhere in the building for a healthy lifestyle in spacious surroundings. Common areas provide various facilities, such as the Lobby Lounge reminiscent of a resort hotel that harmonizes with nature, the Garden Dining room that seats approximately 260 people with a terrace where residents can enjoy a meal with their pets, the Sky View Lounge with ocean views, and hot spring relaxation area with a bath filled with hot spring water from different regions depending on the season and aromatic Löyly sauna. An on-site clinic run by Social Welfare Corporation Taiyo-Kai can be accessed directly by residents via a dedicated entrance, providing a safe and secure home environment.

The property is operated by Mitsui Fudosan Residential Wellness Co., Ltd. and provides hospitality services for residents, including life support services such as reception and concierge.

1. New senior residence in Makuhari Bay-Park, a large-scale neighborhood creation project in Makuhari New City, an area full of diverse commercial facilities including Makuhari Messe and baseball stadium

Makuhari New City has attracted attention in recent years for its excellent residential environment that also offers convenient lifestyles, thanks to its accessible location 29 minutes from Tokyo Station, a spacious park approximately 15 times the size of Tokyo Dome, shopping facilities, and hotels. The property is located in Makuhari Bay-Park in Makuhari New City, one of the largest mixed-use neighborhood creation projects under development in the Tokyo metropolitan area. The total area of the project, which has residential, commercial, and other functions, is approximately 17.5 hectares. Makuhari Bay-Park was developed around a spacious park measuring approximately 984ft (300m) on the long sides. To date, three high-rise condominium buildings, shopping facilities, a clinic mall, and fitness gym have opened. A feature of the neighborhood is that various facilities are available within walking distance. The addition of the property as a housing option makes Makuhari Bay-Park more open to a wider range of ages, making it possible for multiple generations of the same family to live close by.

Every day, Makuhari New City offers diverse leisure activities ranging from one of Kanto's largest fireworks displays to pro baseball games at the stadium and various events at Makuhari Messe. A program of activities and transport will be organized for the property's residents that makes the most of the neighborhood's events. A new ticket gate and exit is scheduled to open at Kaihin Makuhari Station around March 2025, which will make the property even more accessible to the station. In terms of medical facilities, the Chiba Emergency and Psychiatric Medical Center opened in November 2023 following the integration of the Chiba Emergency Medical Center and Chiba Psychiatric Medical Center. A new hospital equipped with the latest medical equipment is scheduled to open in 2026, replacing Chiba Municipal Kaihin Hospital as the nearest hospital to the property. The Makuhari Bay-Park neighborhood is expected to flourish as an area that provides excellent medical facilities.

The property is one of the largest serviced senior residences in Kanto area*1 with 617 units. Its main feature is the largest garden in the PARK WELLSTATE series with approximately 71,042ft² (6,600m²) of green space planted with over 2,400 large and medium-height trees, many of which produce fruit and flowers so that residents can appreciate the palette of the

The spatial design is conducive to spending pleasant moments in nature. The property has 10 gardens, including a large garden open to the public and private courtyard and roof gardens for residents so that they can enjoy natural surroundings even when they are indoors.

3. Excellent facilities including a communal bath that offers three types of hot spring per year and dining room that seats approximately 260 people with expansive views

The interior design of communal facilities is bright, airy, and elegant villa style, harmonizing with the surrounding greenery and water features. The Garden Spa (communal bath), which has a resort feel, uses hot spring water transported from Minakami, Gunma Prefecture and Nasushiobara, Tochigi Prefecture, offering water from three different hot spring sources per year. Other hot bathing and relaxation facilities include an indoor carbonated hot spring bath, which helps to improve blood circulation, outdoor bath nestled in lush greenery, and aromatic Löyly sauna with 100% natural aromatherapy oils. The approximately 260-seat dining room*3 consists of the main dining room with views of the public garden and water features, the Garden Bar, where you can enjoy drinks while admiring the illuminated courtyard garden, and Terrace. With different dining areas to choose from, residents are free to enjoy their meals in a location that suits their current mood. Residents can dine with their pets on the Terrace, where additive-free meals for pets made from natural ingredients are served in collaboration with PETOKOTO inc. In addition, the property provides a library with over 2,100 titles (the largest collection in the PARK WELLSTATE series) produced by BUNKITSU bookstore, a fitness room with views of the park, and Sky View Lounge and Party Room on the top floor offering a stunning vista of sea and sky typical of Makuhari.

4. Provides a nursing care service and day-to-day health management through to emergency support via an on-site clinic in collaboration with Social Welfare Corporation Taiyo-Kai

Kameda Home Clinic Makuhari run by Social Welfare Corporation Taiyo-Kai is based at the property, providing day-to-day consultations as a family physician service. It also offers medical advice on treatments not covered by National Health Insurance, lifestyle advice, annual health checks, and vaccinations. Nurses are on duty 24 hours a day for health advice and emergency response in the health consultation room, as well as support for residents' day-to-day health management and when they feel unwell by organizing consultations at nearby medical institutions and making reservations on their behalf for complete physical examinations.

A nursing care insurance office has also been established by Taiyo-Kai so that residents who require care can use services tailored to each individual in their units. Medical facilities near the property include Makuhari Bay-Park Medical Center, Kameda Clinic, Kameda Makuhari Clinic (a unit of the Kameda Medical Center), Chiba Kaihin Municipal Hospital, and Chiba Emergency and Psychiatric Medical Center, which is reassuring for residents in a medical emergency.

Mitsui Fudosan announced that it would switch to green electricity at all of its facilities in the Tokyo metropolitan area by FY2030. At PARK WELLSTATE Makuhari Bay-Park, we are working on reducing CO2 emissions by using Non-Fossil Fuel Energy Certificates for electricity consumption, and installing total heat exchangers, energy-efficient air-conditioners and lighting equipment, and gas cogeneration systems. At our other facilities, we will also work toward solving social problems through neighborhood creation.

- *2 The "serviced senior residence" is a new type of residence proposed by the Mitsui Fudosan Group for active seniors aiming to lead a richer life suiting their needs. In principle, tenants should be at least 60 years of age and capable of independent living at the time of entering the residence.
