






Quick **step-by-step** guide to use

INSERT PENFILL® CARTRIDGE AND ATTACH NEEDLE

STEP 1 Remove pen cap



STEP 2 Twist off cartridge holder



STEP 3 Insert cartridge, threaded end first




STEP 4 Twist cartridge holder back on until you hear or feel a click




STEP 5 Remove the paper tab from a new needle and push needle straight onto pen



STEP 6 Remove outer and inner needle caps. Keep the outer cap for safe needle disposal







ALWAYS TEST INSULIN FLOW AFTER INSERTING A PENFILL® CARTRIDGE


- STEP 1 Pull out dose button and turn to select 2 units.
- **STEP 2** Press the dose button until the dose counter shows **0** and lines up with the dose pointer.

Insulin should squirt from the needle

STEP 3 Then check in the insulin window to ensure there is no gap between the piston rod head and the piston.

If no insulin appears OR there is a gap, repeat steps 1–3 until the pen is ready for use.







If you do not check the insulin flow you may not receive your full insulin dose.

INJECT YOUR INSULIN

STEP 1 With the dose counter at **0**, pull out the dose button and turn to select the number of units you wish to inject.



STEP 2 Insert the needle and press the dose button until the dose counter shows **0**. Count slowly to **6** before you remove the needle.



Safely remove and dispose of the needle and put the pen cap back on.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

How do I know if there is enough insulin left for my next dose?

Can I remove and replace a partially used Penfill® cartridge?

Why is the piston rod loose?

Turn the dose button until it stops. The dose counter will show either:

- **60** meaning there are **at least 60 units** in the cartridge, or
- a number less than 60 indicating **exactly** how many units are left.

If the cartridge does not contain enough insulin for your next dose, replace with a new Penfill®.

YES. If you remove a Penfill® cartridge and then return it to NovoPen® 6 you **MUST** retest the insulin flow as shown above.

If there is no Penfill® in the pen the piston rod may move back and forth. **This is normal.**
