Parental Leave

After six months of employment, you may be eligible for 11 weeks of paid leave based on your annual salary to bond with a newborn, newly fostered, or adopted child. Parental leave will coordinate with Family and Medical Leave and NYS Paid Family Leave when applicable. Contact your local HR representative for more information.

Lactation Consultants

Compassionate and professional breastfeeding guidance and instructions are available through your NYPA medical plan. Contact your medical plan for details.

Fertility treatment/egg preservation services

In vitro fertilization and fertility preservation services deemed medically necessary due to treatment that may directly or indirectly render a person infertile, such as surgery, radiation or chemotherapy may be covered. Contact your medical plan for details.

Breast pump

Available through our medical plans with choices of top brands and upgrade options.

Mother's lounge

Private, comfortable, and sanitary pumping areas, including daily milk storage, are available in each NYPA location.

Milk storage and shipping solution
