The SunRunner is PSTA's new Bus Rapid Transit service — the first of its kind in Tampa Bay!

From beach to 'Burg, the SunRunner's 10-mile, 30-stop route connects customers to some of Pinellas County's most-visited destinations.

The SunRunner is:

- **Fast** - About 35 minutes from downtown to the beach
- **Frequent** - Service every 15 minutes until 8 p.m.
- **Clean** - Quiet, low-emission vehicles
- **Reliable** - Runs in its own lane to avoid traffic delays



4 Easy Steps to Riding the SunRunner

1 Find your station



Use one of the services below to find your nearest station and to find the stop nearest your destination.

2 Head to your stop

- Look for the yellow SunRunner station
- Plan to arrive 5 minutes before your bus's scheduled departure
- **Running late? Don't worry!** SunRunner buses will arrive every 15 minutes.
- Check your bus's arrival time information on the SunRunner station's **digital display**
- Enjoy **stained-glass designs** by local artist Catherine Woods at select SunRunner stations!

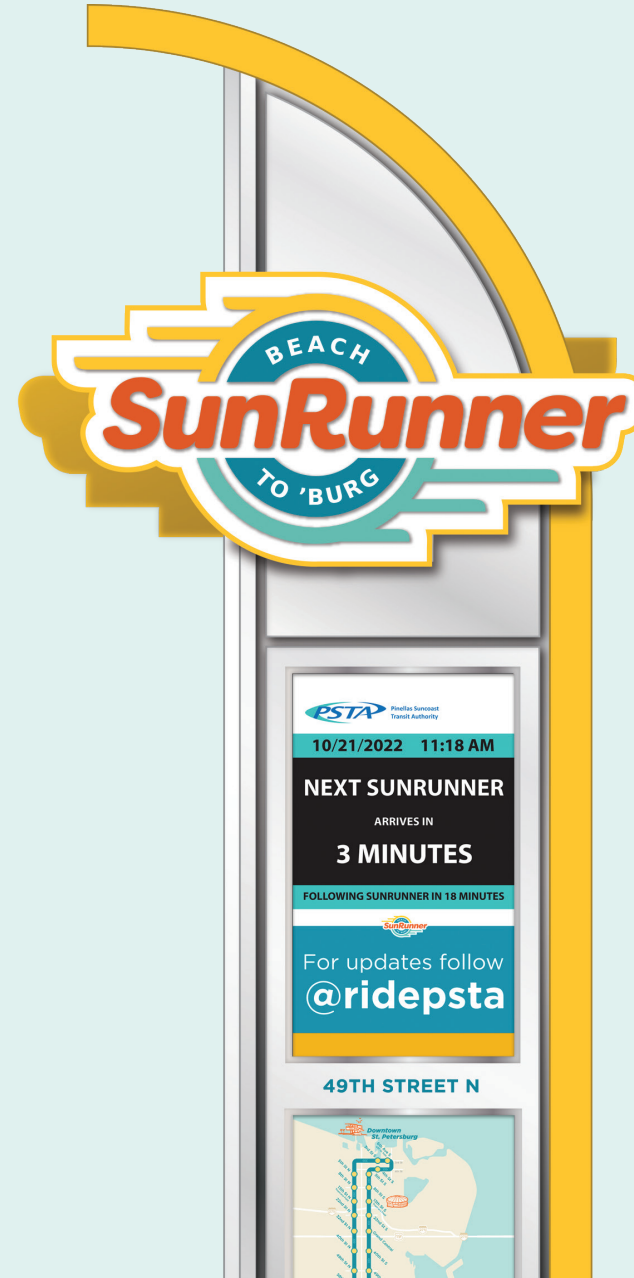

- SunRunner buses have all-door boarding, so passengers can **enter through any door!**
- **Wheelchair passengers** should board using the front door (labeled with an ADA decal).
- For passengers who wish to **bring a bike on board**, please enter through the rear door (labeled with a bike decal).
- **The SunRunner is FREE** for the first six months (through April 2023).
- **Free Wi-Fi and charging ports** at every seat.
- Check the map at your destination station to learn about **landmarks and attractions** in the area.
