on Kashiwa campus

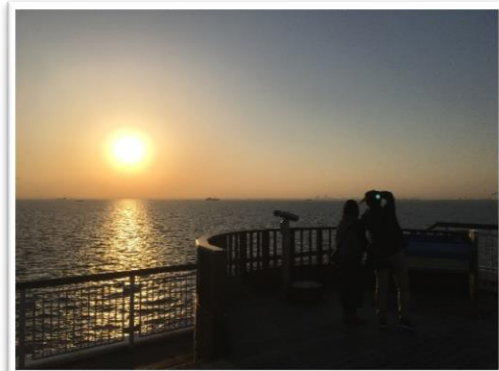


## Tour plan
