Vale is a global mining company headquartered in Rio de Janeiro, Brazil. We are leaders in the production of iron ore and one of the largest global producers of nickel. In Canada, Vale employs approximately 6,000 people at sites in Manitoba, Ontario, and Newfoundland and Labrador, where we produce the metals that are critical to building a cleaner and greener future. Vale's Newfoundland and Labrador Operations are an integrated mining, milling, and processing operation. Operations in Voisey's Bay began in 2005 with an openpit mine and concentrator. All nickel concentrate from Voisey's Bay is shipped to the Long Harbour Processing plant where it is produced into nickel, cobalt and copper metal.

As a fly in/fly out operation, Voisey's Bay boasts significant infrastructure to support the business and to ensure a safe and comfortable living environment for the people that work at the site.

Voisey's Bay has entered into two separate Impacts and Benefits Agreements (IBAs) with Innu Nation and the Nunatsiavut Government; IBAs are confidential legally binding agreements and include focus on benefits relating to jobs, training and procurement opportunities.

Job Readiness Training Program (JRTP)

Program Overview

The Job Readiness Training Program is designed to introduce new employees to our Mill, Mine and Maintenance departments while gaining experience in an industrial environment. At the successful completion of the program, candidates will be qualified for an entry level position within those departments.

These positions are based at the Voisey's Bay mine site in Labrador, a fly-in fly-out operation, with a two-week on, two week off rotation.

In this position, you will:

- Ensure knowledge of all safety policies and strictly adhere to them.
- Become familiar with the safe work practices and standard operating procedures.
- Perform pre-operational checks, and operate equipment according to standard operating procedures.
- Monitor equipment and processes, and conduct troubleshooting activities when problems arise.
- · Perform housekeeping activities.
- · Complete training as required.
- · Participate in crew safety meetings.



About You

- Candidates must be a member of Innu Nation or a Nunatsiavut Beneficiary.
- 6 months of industrial experience and/or heavy equipment operation would be considered an asset.
- Demonstrate concern for Safety, Health and Environment.
- Strong ability to work cooperatively within a team environment.
- Demonstrate initiative and follow instructions.
- Able to recognize hazards in an industrial workplace.

Education Requirement

Minimum completion of Grade 10 secondary school.

Program Duration 9 months.


