Preferred Seating – Trade FAQ

- 1. What is Preferred Seating?
 - Preferred Seating is a paid Economy seating option which our guests can select.
 - These seats are in the forward half of the aircraft, behind the front Economy X zone (where applicable).
- 2. What is the key benefit of Preferred Seating?
 - The key benefit of Preferred Seating is being seated closer to the forward aircraft door and therefore enabling faster disembarkation. Note: These seats do not have any additional legroom.
- 3. What is difference between Preferred Seating Zone 1 and Zone 2?
 - Where applicable, the Preferred Seat zones are sectioned depending on how far forward the seat is to the front. On a 737-800 aircraft:
 - *i.* Zone 1 = rows 6-9
 - *ii.* Zone 2 = rows 10-12

Each zone will have a different price.

- 4. Who pays for Preferred Seating?
 - All Silver, Red and Non-Members can pay for Preferred Seats at the time of booking or through 'Manage my Booking' on a Choice or Flex fares.
 - Platinum and Gold members traveling on a Choice or Flex fare can select Preferred Seating for themselves and up to 8 accompanying guests free of charge.
 - Any remaining Preferred Seats available through the check in channels can be selected free of charge by all guests on a Choice and Flex fare.
- 5. What happens if I need to change my flight?
 - For guests who need to voluntarily change their flight they will need to select a seat when changing their flight. The original seat Electronic Miscellaneous Document (EMD) will be refunded, and the new seat EMD will be charged.
- 6. What happens if I need to cancel my flight?
 - If you have purchased a Preferred Seat and voluntarily cancel your booking, the preferred seat fee will not be refunded.
- 7. My flight was changed, and I no longer have Preferred Seating. Can I get a refund?
 - In the event Virgin Australia change your flight and a preferred seat is not available, you may request a refund through BSP. Please note if Virgin Australia accommodate you in an Economy X seat, no refund is applicable.
- 8. Is Preferred Seating available on all flights?
 - All Regular Passenger Transport (RPT) services operated on Virgin Australia/Virgin Australia International and VARA aircraft will offer preferred seating.
 - RPT services operated by Link Airways, Alliance Airlines and Air North with a VA flight number will also offer Preferred Seating.

9. How much is Preferred Seating?

• Preferred Seating prices are determined by the market and zone selected. Prices below include GST.

- 10. There are no free seats to select when making my booking, what can I do?
 - For guests on a Choice or Flex fare, if all standard seats are taken at the time of making a booking and guests do not wish to pay for a seat, they may wait until check in opens (48 hours for domestic flights) and select a Preferred Seat free of charge.
- 11. Why are some Preferred Seats more expensive than others?
 - Guests selecting a Preferred Seat in Zone 1 will attract a higher price due to the closer proximity to the front of the aircraft.
- 12. I have recently changed from a Silver Member to a Gold Member, can I get Preferred Seating free of charge on my existing booking?
 - Tier recognition for seating benefits will apply at the time you are selecting your seat.
- 13. I am travelling on a Choice or Flex fare. When can I select Preferred Seats free of charge?
 - For Velocity Gold and Platinum members you may select a preferred seat free of charge at the time you make your booking for you and up to 8 accompanying guests.
 - For Velocity Silver, Red and Non-Members you will need to wait until check in opens to select a Preferred Seat for free, subject to availability.
- 14. My seat has changed from a Preferred Seat on a Window to an Aisle, can I get a refund?
 - In the event Virgin Australia changes your flight and a 'like for like' Preferred Seat is not available; you may request a refund through BSP. Please note if Virgin Australia accommodate you in an Economy X seat, no refund is applicable.
- 15. Do I earn Velocity Points when I purchase Preferred Seats?
 - Guests will earn Velocity Points in accordance with their fare type however Points earn is not available for Preferred Seat purchases.
