**Information on some of our Northumberland Towns and Villages**

**Alnmouth**  
A picture-perfect seaside village with colourful houses & golden sands. Golf course, gift shops, pubs, cafés.

**Alnwick**  
Vibrant town with heritage preserved Aln Valley Railway. Eateries, gift shops & quirky second-hand bookshop. Home to Alnwick Castle, The Alnwick Garden, Baillifgate Museum & Alnwick Playhouse.

**Amble**  
Traditional fishing village, host to the annual Puffin Festival. Harbour with fish shacks, eateries & painted beach huts. Nearby nature reserve.

**Ashington**  
Former coal mining village now one of Northumberland's largest towns. Home to Woodhorn Museum & Queen Elizabeth II Park.

**Bamburgh**  
Voted one of the best beaches in England. Home to Lord Armstrong's Bamburgh Castle & RNLI Grace Darling Museum.

**Bellingham**  
Charming riverside village in beautiful countryside. Waterfalls, trails, and cycling routes Heritage centre.

**Berwick**  
England's northern-most town. Army museum, Berwick Town Museum, & historic stone bridge. Boat trips, Town Wall & beach walks.

**Blyth**  
Once one of England's busiest ports due to its coal mining and ship building industries. Still a working port with busy quayside & promenade lined with brightly painted beach huts.

**Chillingham**  
Famous for its "haunted" castle & Chillingham Cattle.

**Corbridge**  
Attractive town "Corstopitum", originally a bustling Roman supply town to nearby Chesters and Housesteads Roman Forts & Roman Vindolanda. Traditional pubs & independent shops.

**Craster**  
Famous for its smokehouses & home of the British kipper. Charming harbour.

**Embleton**  
Small ancient village with Norman church famous for Embleton Bay, a sheltered sandy beach popular for water sports and bird watching. Village Farm Shop.

**Farne Islands**  
Cluster of rocky islands. Habitat for seals & seabirds, including puffins. Accessible by boat from Seahouses.

**Ford & Etal**  
Two historic villages. Historic 14th Century castle, heritage museum, bloody battlefields of Flodden, working flour mill, heavy horse centre & Heatherslaw light railway.

**Haltwhistle**  
Picturesque town with rich border heritage, the geographic centre of Britain. Open-air swimming pools & almost intact section of Hadrian's Wall.

**Haydon Bridge**  
An idyllic location with the river at its heart. 14th century bridge, Mr George's Museum of Time & John Martin walking trail.

**Heddon on the Wall**  
Small attractive village home to the first long Stretch of Hadrian's Wall west of Newcastle. Saxon & Methodist Churches.

**Hexham**  
Busy historic market town clustered around the Medieval Abbey. Old Gaol, independent shops, cafés eateries, art deco cinema, arts centre, walks, fishing, golf & many other activities.

**Holy Island**  
Tidal island occupied by priests since the 600s. Priory & Museum telling the Island's story. Home to Lindsifarne Castle & Lindsifarne Mead.

**Kielder**  
Tiny village famous for its water & forest park & observatory, located within the International Dark Sky Park.

**Morpeth**  
Quaint cobbled streets, historic buildings & rich history. Cafés, eateries, shopping & bars. Nearby Whitehouse Farm Centre.

**Newbiggin by the Sea**  
Small fishing port with idyllic beach. Maritime Centre & Heritage Museum. Sean Henry's sculpture 'Couple'.

**Newton by the Sea**  
Delightful village renowned for bird watching. Popular for watersports, and fine views across Embleton Bay to Dunstanburgh Castle.

**Rothbury**  
Bustling sandstone market village, capital of Coquetdale. Home to Cragside, Lord Armstrong's Country House, the first to be lit by hydroelectric power. Pubs, cafés & galleries.

**Seahouses**  
Traditional fishing village, starting point for boat trips to the Farne Islands, renowned for their stunning bird life. Pubs, shops & cafés.

**Warkworth**  
Medieval village dominated by Warkworth Castle. Home to the famous Harry Hotspur of Northumberland.

**Wooler**  
Walker's paradise! Tiny, stone-build historic market town in the foothills of the Cheviots. Bustline High Street with traditional shops, pubs & cafés. Ad Gefrin Distillery, Farm safaris and Maelmin Henge & Heritage Trail.
