- (1) The Convention entered into force on 5 September 1969, i.e., three months after five States had signed it without reservation, the fifth such signature having been deposited on 5 June 1969. For five other States it entered into force three months after deposit of signature without reservation by 30 June 1969. For any other State, it enters into force three months after deposit of the instrument of ratification or accession.
- The Convention applies to the Customs territory of Denmark except for the Faroe Islands and (2) Greenland.
- Extended to Papua, Norfolk, Christmas and Cocos (Keeling) Islands and the Trust Territory of (3)New Guinea, with effect from 10 December 1969.
- (4) Extended to the Bailiwick of Guernsey and the Isle of Man with effect from 15 March 1970, and to the Bailiwick of Jersey with effect from 15 April 1970. Extended with effect from 4 December 1970 to Bermuda, Belize, Gibraltar, Pitcairn, Seychelles, Saint Helena, the Gilbert and Ellice Islands, Montserrat and the Virgin Islands.
- (5) The provisions of the Convention have been applied since 4 November 1969.
- Extended to the Condominium of the New Hebrides with effect from 4 April 1971. (6)
- (7) Extended to the Principality of Liechtenstein for such time as the Treaty of Customs Union with Switzerland remains in force.

Note: The Embassy of the People's Republic of China in Belgium has notified the Secretary General, by a communication received on 7 March 2000, of the following:

"The Customs Convention on the Temporary Importation of Scientific Equipment, done at Brussels on 11 June 1968 (hereinafter referred to as the Convention), which applies to Macao at present, will continue to apply to the Macao Special Administrative Region with effect from 20 December 1999.

Within the above ambit, the Government of the People's Republic of China will assume the responsibility for the international rights and obligations that places on a Party to the Convention.'
