Severe thunderstorms formed during the afternoon along a low-pressure trough in western Oklahoma and a warm front moving northward across the state. The storms moved into central and southeastern Oklahoma during the afternoon and evening, before weakening during the early morning hours of the 22nd. In all, ten tornados, baseball-sized hail, straight-line wind damage, and lightning damage were reported.

The first tornado was reported 2 miles east of Perry in Noble County. The following 5 tornados occurred in Carter County in Ratliff City, in Jefferson/Carter Counties from north of Ringling to west of Healdton, 8 miles north of Healdton, 5 miles south of Healdton, and 5 miles southeast of Fox. The final 4 tornados occurred in Murray County 5 miles northwest of Sulphur, 2.5 miles southeast of Davis, 2 miles west of Sulphur, and near Hickory. (See individual reports for more information.)

Hail as large as softballs fell across the Newkirk area. One hailstone, reported to be "as large as a human head", fell through the roof and ceiling into the living room of a home in southeast Newkirk.

An unfortunate flock of ducks was caught in the storm, and several residents saw ducks falling with the hail.
