Summary of events of August 10, 1997:

Evening thunderstorms moved across western Oklahoma, producing severe winds and flash flooding. Wind speeds were clocked at up to 61 mph in Altus in Jackson County, and wind damage was reported in Sentinel in Washita County and Manitou in Tillman County.

Flash flooding was most extensive in Hobart in Kiowa County, where 8.6 inches of rain fell in less than 12 hours as thunderstorms reformed several times and moved over the same area. Homes, businesses, and streets in Hobart were flooded, numerous cars were stalled in high water, and several people had to be evacuated.

A combination of severe thunderstorm winds estimated at 80 mph and 2-inch hail blew out nearly all of the north-facing windows at the Alfalfa County School. Damage to the school was estimated at \$25,000, but no injuries occurred since the students and teachers had moved to a storm shelter. Throughout the town of Burlington, trees up to 10 inches in diameter were blown over, power lines were blown down, and numerous homes received roof and window damage from the wind and hail.

Summary of events of the very early morning hours of August 22, 1997:

A cluster of severe thunderstorms moved rapidly south out of southern Kansas and into northern Oklahoma shortly after midnight (CST) on the 22nd. The storms moved almost due south across the western portions of Oklahoma during the early morning hours, leaving a trail of severe wind damage in their wake. The highest measured wind speed reached 84 mph, measured at the Oklahoma Mesonet site near Bessie in Washita County. Reports of tree, limb, fence, sign, and power line damage were common, stretching from Harper to Kay County along the Oklahoma/Kansas border and then southward across the state to as far south as Tillman and Carter Counties in extreme southern Oklahoma. Structural wind damage was reported near Cherokee in Alfalfa County, in Laverne and May in Harper County, in Woodward County, in Carnegie, Cyril, and Fort Cobb in Caddo County, in Fort Sill in Comanche County, in Chickasha in Grady County, and near Wilson in Carter County.

Summary of events of the afternoon and evening of August 17, 1997:

Severe thunderstorms moved along and south of the Red River, producing large hail, damaging thunderstorm winds, and two tornadoes in western parts of north Texas. The tornadoes were observed south of Windthorst in Archer County. No damage was reported and both were rated at F0.

The largest hail was reported near Harrold in Wilbarger County, where hail reached the size of golf balls.

The most significant wind damage occurred in Clay County, where severe thunderstorm winds caused major damage to a group of houses and barns and then derailed a freight train near Jolly. Significant wind damage was also reported in the Henrietta area of Clay County and in Iowa park in Wichita County.
