A 12- or 16-week course that prepares Job Seekers with Disabilities for Environmental Services or Floor Technician jobs.

The Environmental Services Training Programs are offered at DORS WTC location.

This program has three training options.
Each training program can be completed as a stand-alone program:

- ◆ 12-week housekeeping course
- ◆ 12-week floor technician course
- ◆ 16-week combined housekeeping/ floor technician program



TRAINING INCLUDES

- Bathroom cleaning
- Carpet cleaning
- Collecting trash
- Floor stripping & waxing
- Office cleaning
- Performing routine maintenance
- Replenishing supplies
- Upholstery cleaning
- Window cleaning



PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

ABILITY TO:

- Do the same jobs many times
- Follow verbal & written directions
- Lift up to 50 pounds
- Measure & mix cleaners
- Stand, stoop, bend & stretch for a long period of time
- Work alone or with a group
