Alert Peace Officers with the code:

COMMUNICATION IMPEDIMENT

- 1 Add Communication Impediment to your driver license or ID
 - Have your physician complete and sign Physician's Statement Form (CL101) affirming your diagnosis.
 - Visit your local driver license office for a driver license application (DL14A/S). Complete Line 7.
- 2 Add Communication Impediment to your vehicle when registering through the Department of Motor Vehicles. This option will alert an officer prior to approaching your vehicle in a pull-over.
