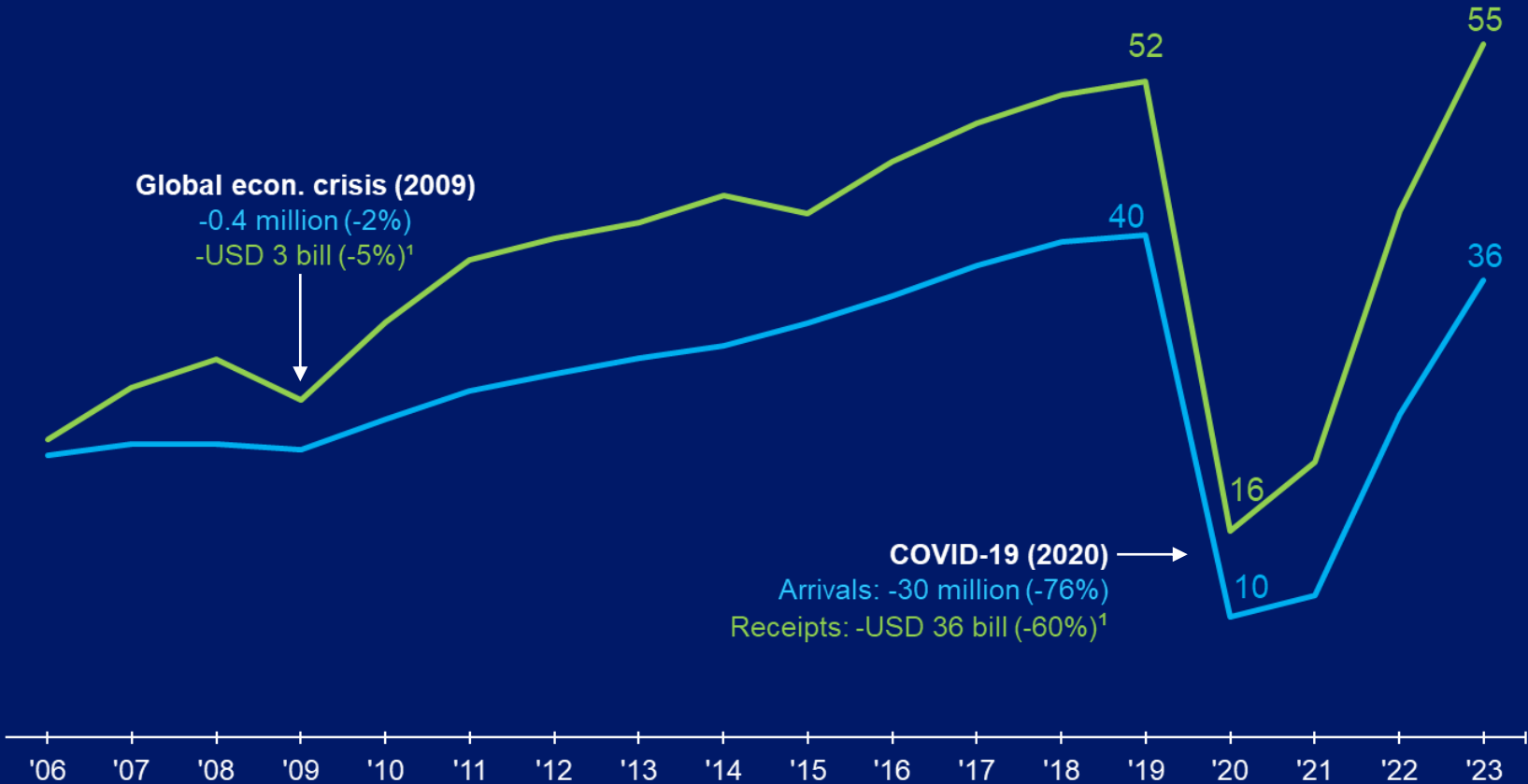
SIDS: International tourist arrivals and receipts

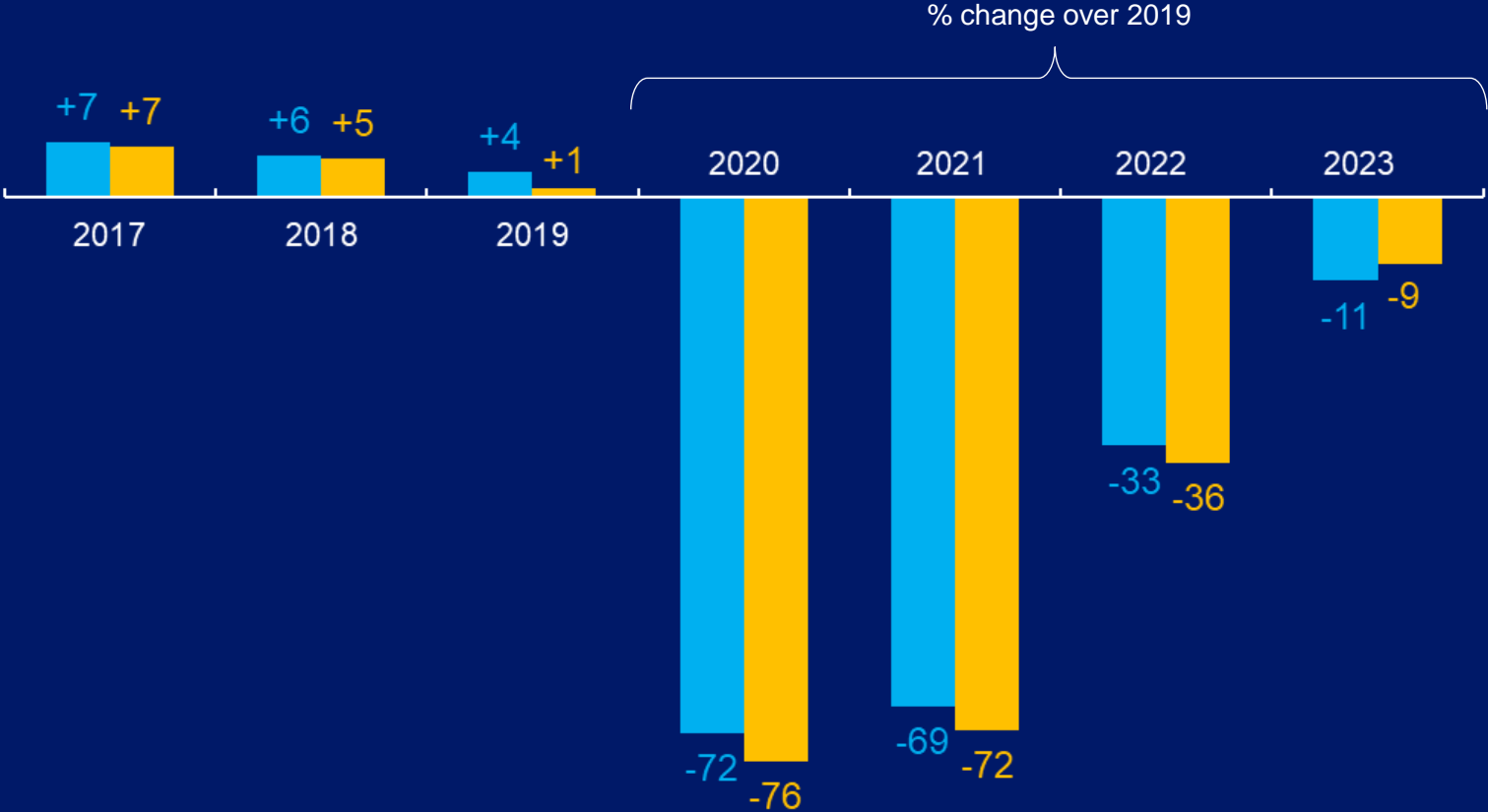

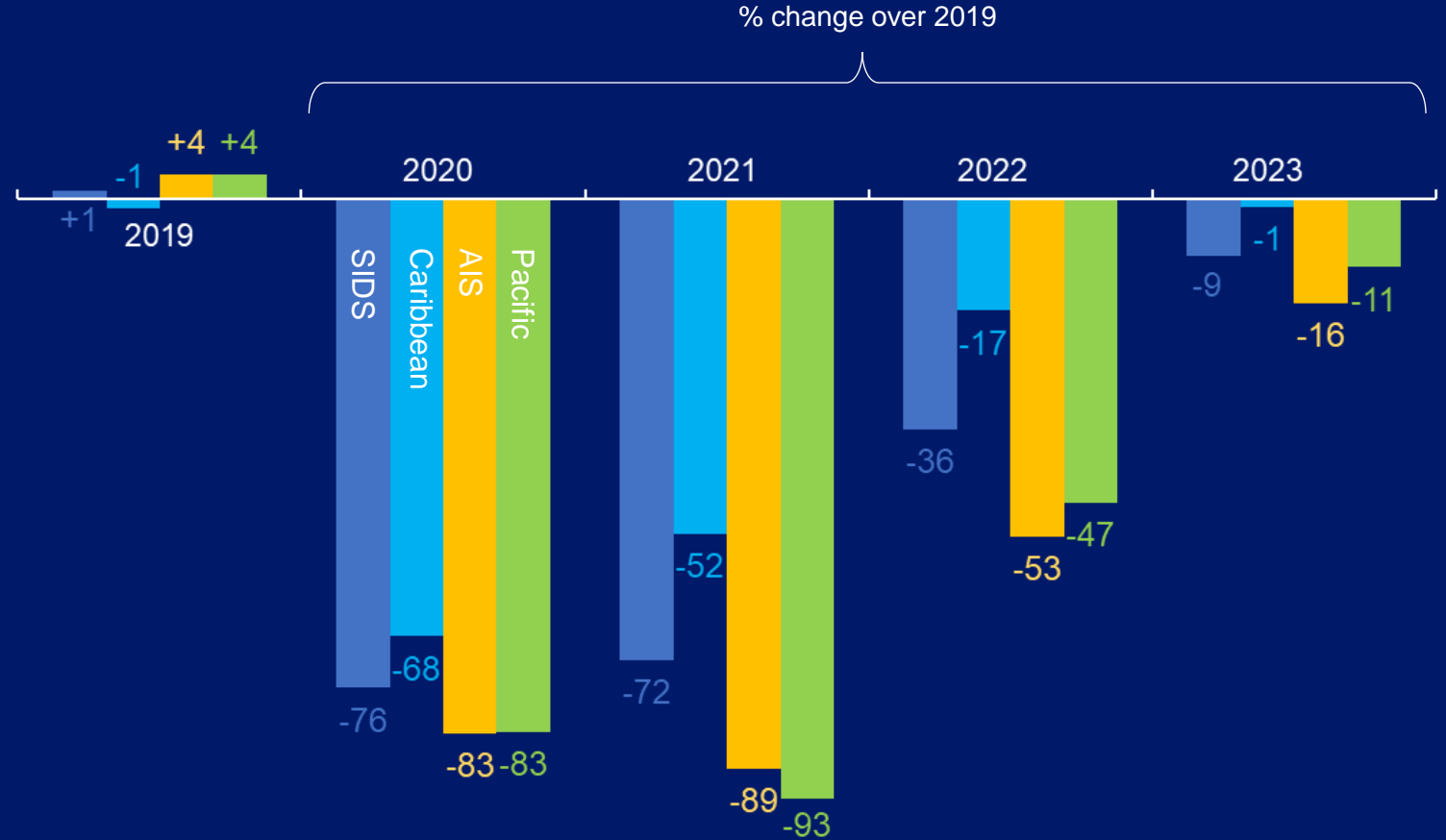

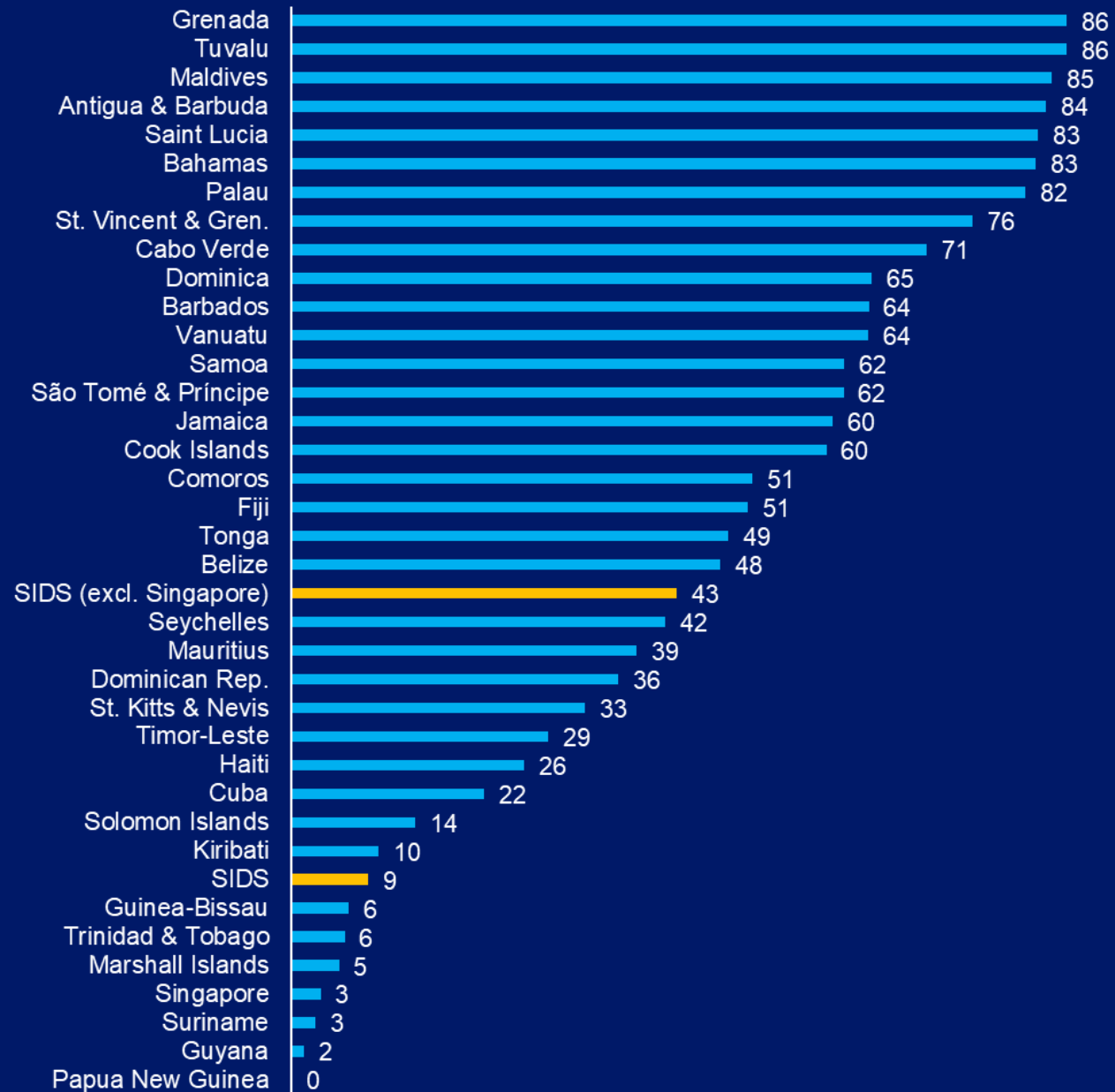

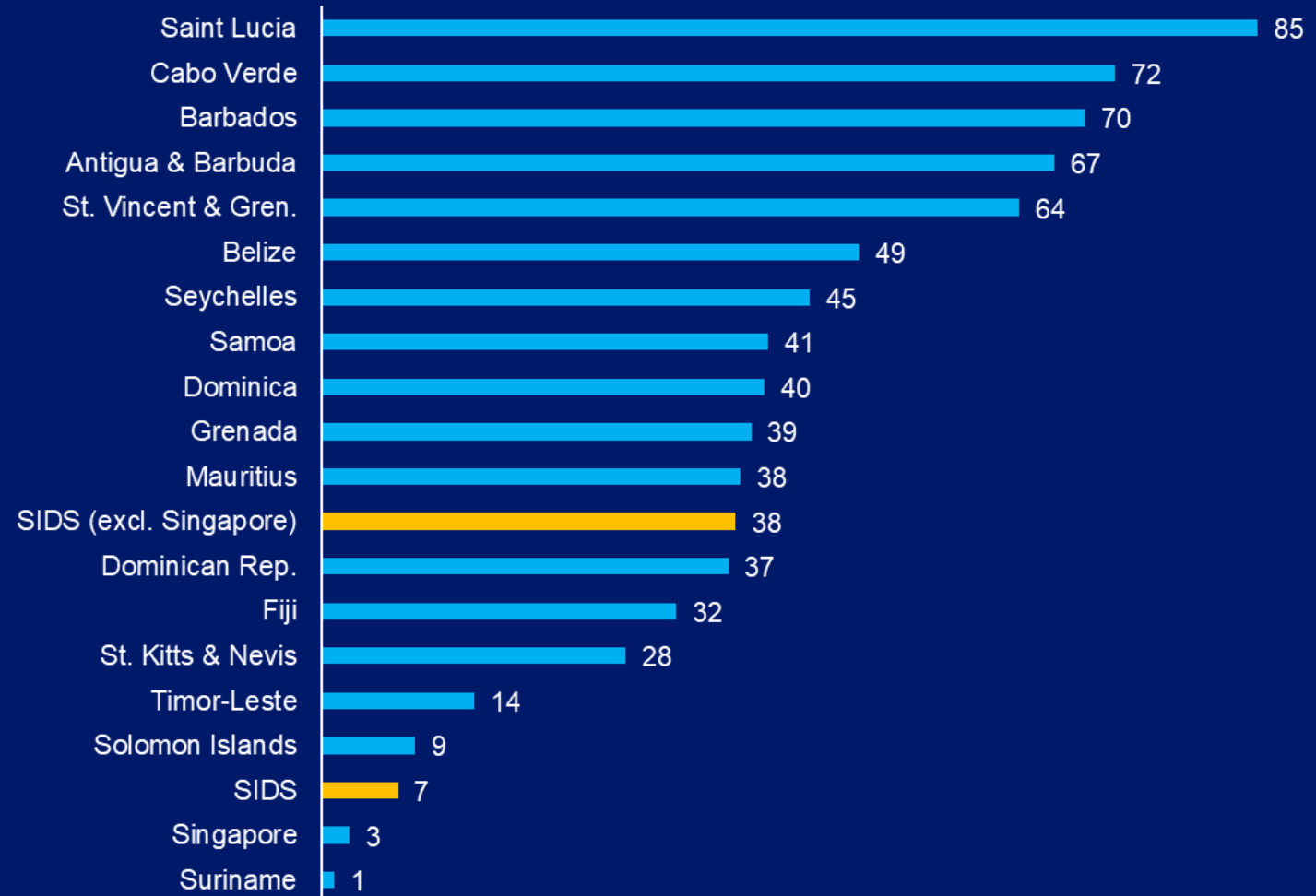

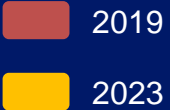

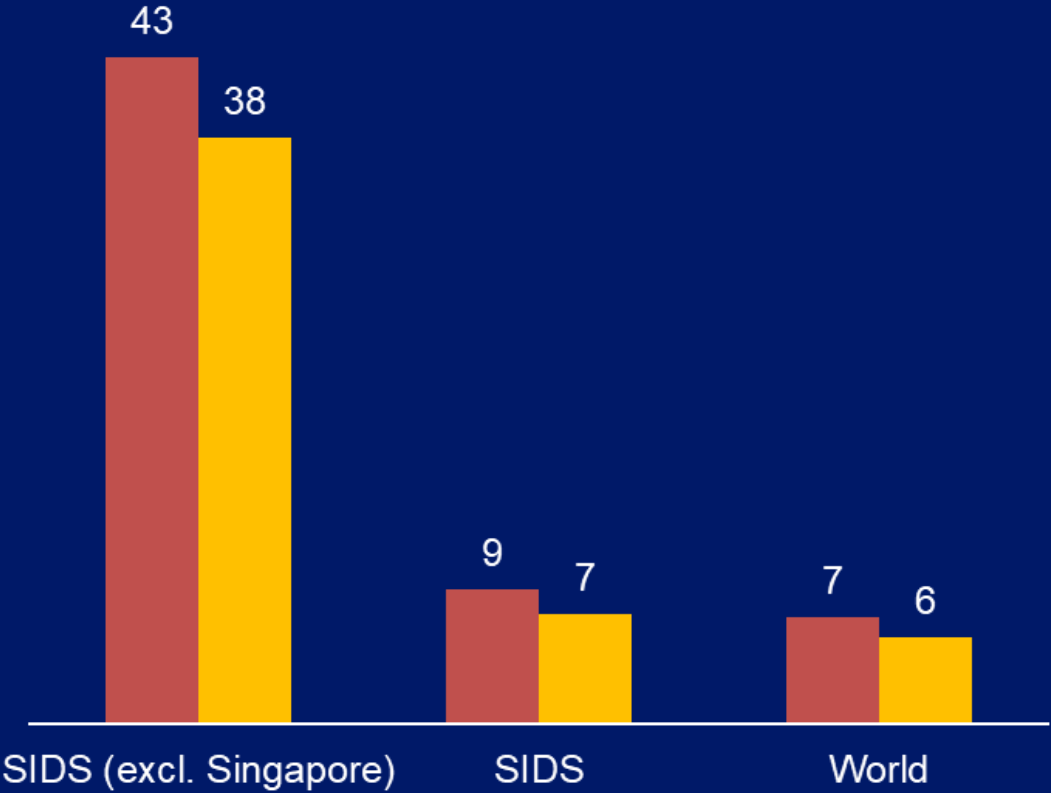

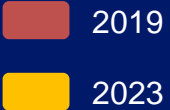

2019 & 2023



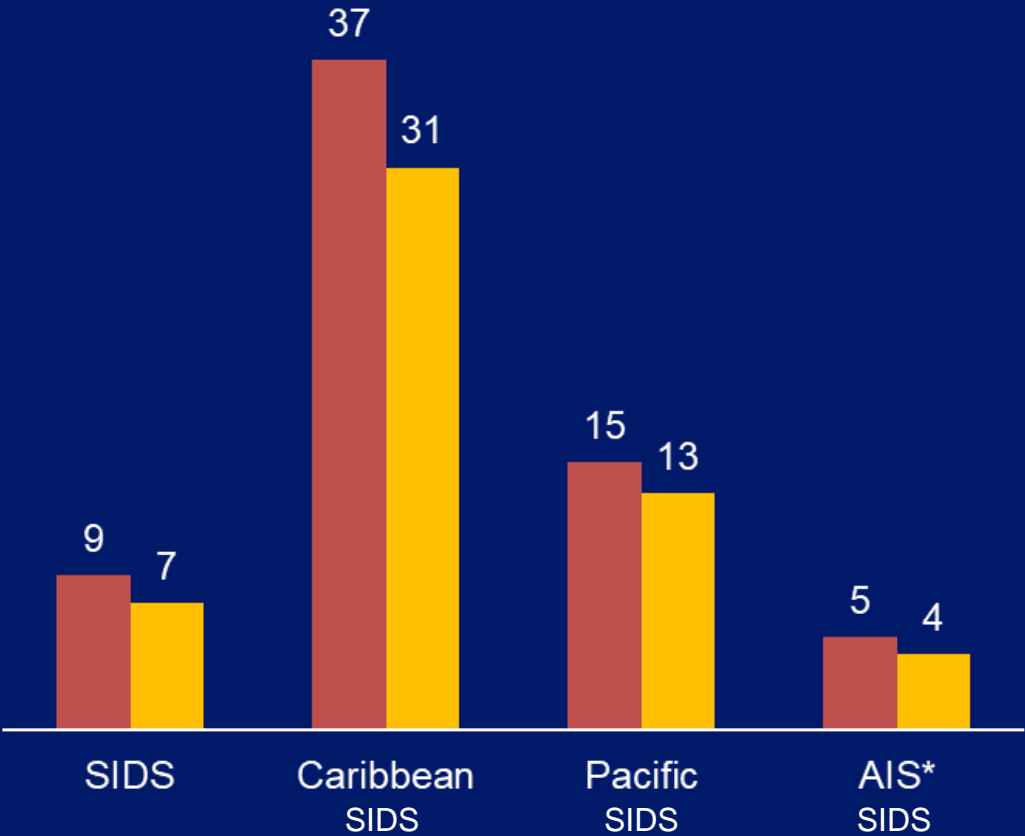

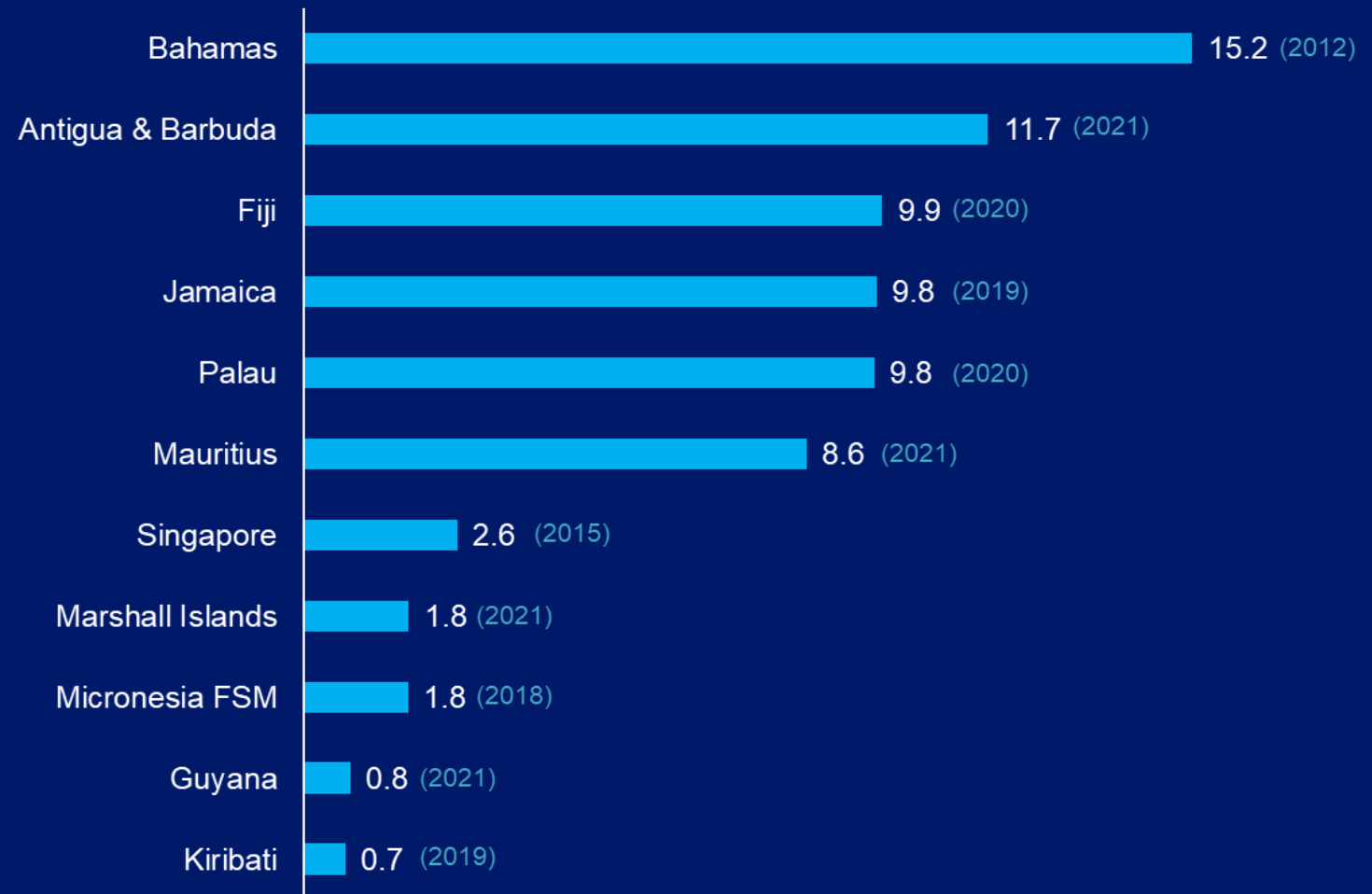

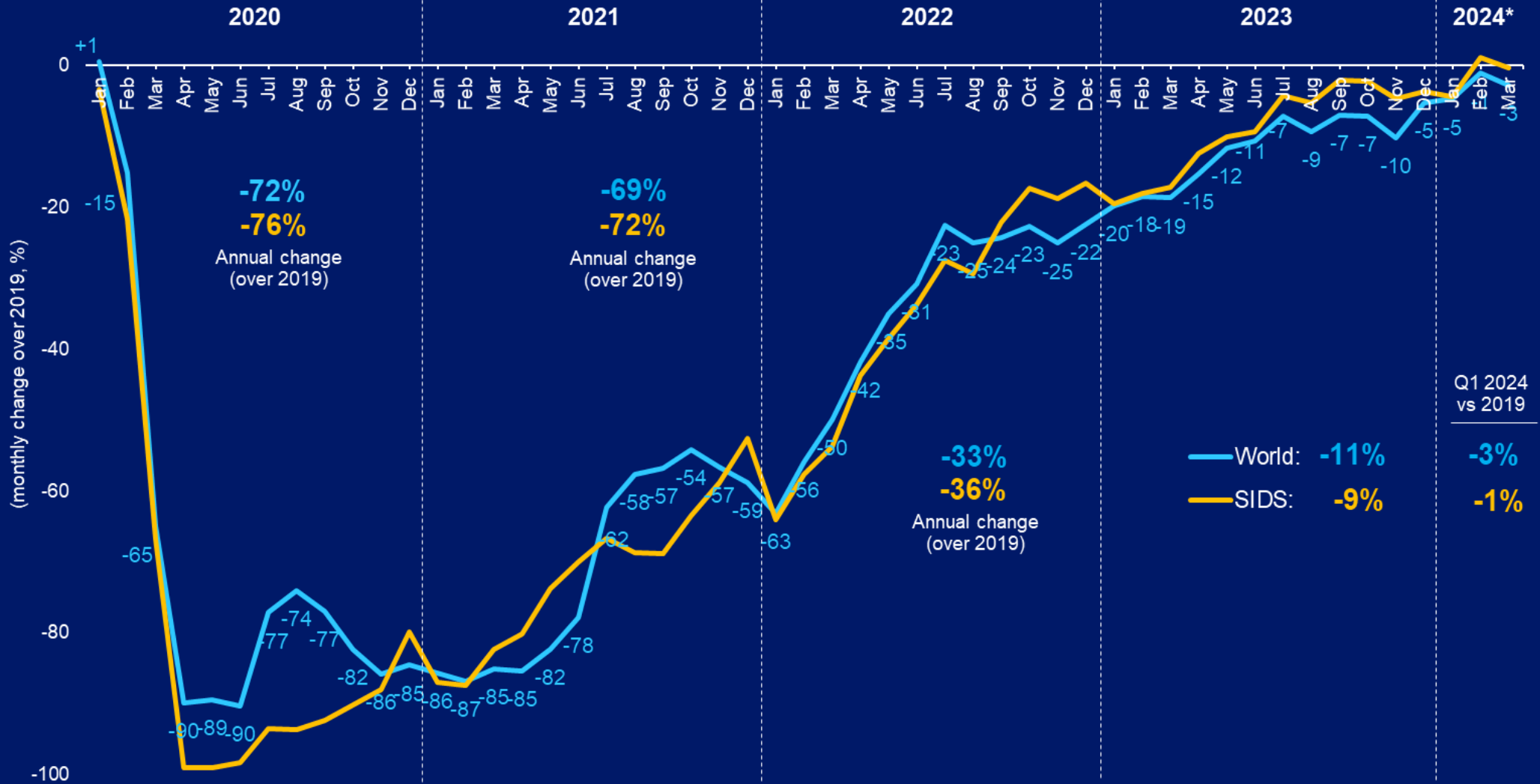

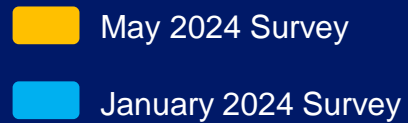
International tourist arrivals, 2020-2023 and Projection for 2024 (monthly % change over 2019)
