Outlook Period: Wednesday 07/17/24 - Sunday 07/21/24

OVERVIEW:

Hot and humid conditions will continue through today with a better chance for convection than previous days. Showers and thunderstorms will become more widespread as a front stalls in the area on Thursday through much of the upcoming weekend. Isolated severe weather is possible on Thursday.

HAZARDS & IMPACTS	 Land: For Wednesday, a Heat Advisory is in effect for the entire area from 11AM to 8PM. Another Heat Advisory may be needed Thursday. Isolated strong to severe thunderstorms are possible Thursday, with isolated flash flooding possible late in the week. Beach/Surf: For Wednesday, High risk of Rip Currents for all beaches except Georgetown County beaches, which has a Moderate Risk. All beaches besides Brunswick County beaches will experience a strong south to north longshore current. The rip risk is expected to decrease on Friday and Saturday, but may remain Moderate due to persistent southerly swells. Click here for more details. Marine: For Wednesday, a Small Craft Advisory is in place for the coastal waters from noon to 9AM Thursday. Isolated strong to severe thunderstorms are possible Thursday.
