

**64 railway and bus companies in the Kanto region established the “Greater Tokyo Pass Council”
Unlimited Rides on Railways of 12 Participating Private Railway Companies in Kanto Area
and Buses of 52 Companies in Metropolitan Tokyo and Surrounding 3 Prefectures!
A New Plan Ticket for Foreign Visitors,
the “Greater Tokyo Pass” is Scheduled to be Released.**

On April 1 (Sun.), 2018, the “Greater Tokyo Pass Council” (established on February 28, 2018 – For details, refer to the accompanying page) will initiate sales of the “Greater Tokyo Pass,” a new Plan Ticket for foreign visitors to Japan.

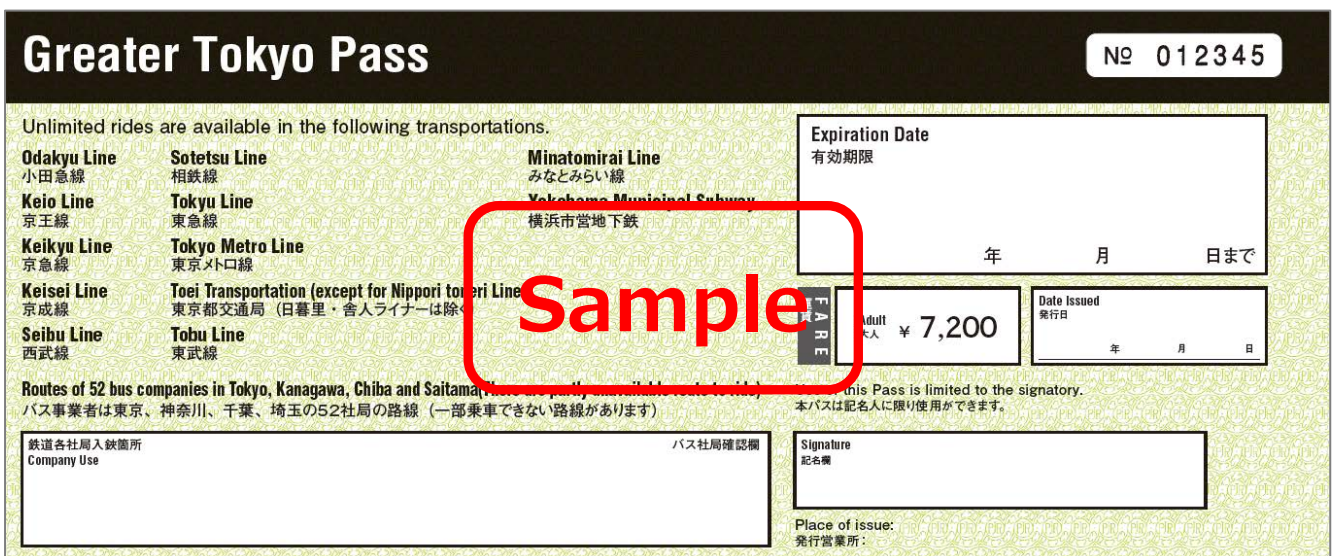
The “Greater Tokyo Pass” is a Plan Ticket for three days of unlimited rides on railways and streetcars operated by 12 companies and ordinary fixed-route buses operated by 52 companies in the Kanto area. It will be sold for 7,200 yen for adults and 3,600 yen (tax inclusive) for children at facilities at Narita Airport and Haneda Airport operated by the participating companies and at tourist information centers for foreign visitors at major stations.

Purchasers of the “Greater Tokyo Pass” can take advantage of unlimited rides on railways, streetcars, and ordinary fixed-route buses at a set price, enabling them to save money as they enjoy sightseeing in the Kanto area. In addition, one of the difficulties that foreign visitors to Japan face is that they find public transportation systems “too complicated and difficult to use.” However, with the “Greater Tokyo Pass,” they will be able to use a single ticket to ride on railways, streetcars, and ordinary fixed-route buses, making moving around in the Kanto area much more efficient as they will not be required to purchase a new ticket every time they wish to ride again.

The “Greater Tokyo Pass Council” is cooperating with the participating companies to make travel in the Kanto area more enjoyable for foreign visitors and will strive to share information such as travel destination ideas using the Greater Tokyo Pass.

Regarding Sales of “Greater Tokyo Pass”

- 1. Ticket Name:** Greater Tokyo Pass
- 2. Sales launch date:** April 1 (Sun.), 2018
- 3. Details:** Unlimited ride ticket for railways, streetcars and ordinary fixed-route buses in the area from participating transportation companies in Kanto area
- 4. Can be purchased by:** Foreign visitors to Japan

- 5. Permitted usage area:**
- Railways and streetcars operated by 12 companies
All lines as part of the Odakyu Line, Keio Line, Keisei Line ^(note), Keikyu Line, Sotetsu Line, Seibu Line, Tokyu Line, Tokyo Metro Line, Toei Subway, Tokyo Sakura Tram (Toden Arakawa Line), Tobu Line, Minatomirai Line, and Yokohama Municipal Subway.

* Separate fares will be charged when using limited express trains requiring a fare, reserved seating trains, etc.

Note: When including the Narita SKY ACCESS Line section (Keisei Takasago Sta. - Narita Airport Terminal1 Sta.) on the Keisei Line, the ticket may only be used between the following stations:

- ① Traveling among all stations of the Keisei Line excluding Hokuso Line section (between Shinshibamata Sta. - Inba Nihon-idaï Sta.) and Narita - Yukawa Sta., Narita Airport Terminal 2・3 Sta. or Narita Airport Terminal 1 Sta.
- ② Traveling among all stations between Inba Nihon-idaï Sta. -Narita-Yukawa Sta. - Narita Airport Terminal 2・3 Sta.

- Ordinary fixed-route buses operated by 52 companies in Tokyo, Kanagawa, Chiba, and Saitama.

- * The ticket may not be used on restricted-seating capacity buses (highway express buses, airport access buses, regular tour buses, etc.), night express buses, local government community buses, buses on joint-operation systems with non-participating companies.

- 6. Validity:** 3 days from date of purchase
 * Whatever time of day the ticket is first used, even late at night, etc., that day shall be counted as the first day of use.
- 7. Sales Prices:** 7,200 yen Adults; 3,600 yen Children * Both are tax inclusive fares.
- 8. Material:** Paper ticket (Cannot be used at an automatic ticket gate.)
- 9. Sales method:** Sold only upon presentation of a passport to verify the purchaser is a foreign visitor. At that time, a signature matching the one displayed on the passport will be required.
- 10. Methods of use:**
- Railways
 Use ticket at manned ticket gates.
 (Cannot be used at automatic ticket gates.)
 - Streetcars / Ordinary fixed route buses
 Present ticket to attendants.
- * The passenger may be required to present their passport in order to verify their identity.
