### **MISSION**

### Building community through the arts

Perry County Council of the Arts accomplishes our mission by encouraging the creative spirit in adults and children, supporting artists and celebrating their successes, enhancing the local economy, and implementing enriching Arts in Education initiatives throughout 7 Central PA counties.

PCCA board, staff and volunteers strive to fulfill the mission by helping artists become more economically viable, encouraging adults and young people to explore various art forms and providing local programs that community members can join as participants or members of an audience.

### 4 CORE PROGRAMS CONNECT PEOPLE IN OUR COMMUNITY

Through a partnership with Pennsylvania Council on the Arts, PCCA administers **Arts in Education** residencies in 7 counties—Perry, Juniata, Mifflin, Montour, Snyder, Union and Northumberland—linking professional artists with schools, senior facilities, libraries, and other organizations, in-person and virtually. Participants collaborate on a project for a culminating event, private installation or public art piece.

Our **Community Programs** serve audiences of all ages with events and artistic opportunities that are often low cost, free, or discounted to PCCA members. These include classes; poetry and book readings; concerts and performances; Coffeehouse open mic nights; bus trips; Drop-In Art; and Summer Art Camp.

**PCCA Gallery** staff provides sales and marketing support to Central PA artists and makers of every discipline and skill level. Member artists can display and sell their works at PCCA Gallery, Landis House exhibitions, Art on Tour traveling displays, and online.

Mary Landis donated Landis House to PCCA in 2007 at the time of her death, in honor of her parents. PCCA hosts rotating exhibitions, classes, concerts, art camps, community meetings, and other events at Landis House, while displaying Landis Family art and artifacts.

### **Arts in Education Liverpool Mural**

PCCA Teaching Artist Jon Laidacker led an Artist Residency at Greenwood High School to capture the rich history of Liverpool in a beautiful public mural. While Laidacker and the students wrapped up the residency in 2019, the coronavirus delayed our plans for a dedication, which was later able to occur in Spring 2021. ### **Art Uplifts**

Created in 2020 as a response to the coronavirus pandemic, this inspiring outdoor art show features uplifting work from our member artists, printed on durable yard signs and displayed in community parks. In 2021, this popular exhibit featured the inspirational work of both PCCA member artists and Youth Art Day students.

### **Inclusive Art Classes**

### **Gallery Exhibitions**

Local and regional artists displayed their original works of art and handmade items in PCCA Gallery visual art shows. In 2021, Gallery exhibitions included "Art of a Pandemic" and "Director's Choice," featuring outstanding student artwork from Youth Art Day.

### **Poetic Excellence Awards**

Our annual poetry contest invites local poets to share their creative writing for judging by an established poet selected by PCCA. Each year, the contest culminates to an awards ceremony, where winning poets are honored and invited to read their original works. We were happy to host the event in person again in 2021 at Buddy Boy Winery, Duncannon, after celebrating virtually in 2020. The festivities continued with live music, poetry readings and storytelling during PCCA's Coffeehouse Open Mic, following the ceremony.

### **Summer Art Camp**

Creative instructors of various disciplines share their knowlege and love of the arts with young people throughout our community in weeklong sessions. Over the years, art campers have explored poetry, visual art, dancing, music, and digital art. ### **Youth Art Day**

PCCA's annual student art showcase features the work of school students throughout Perry County in a visual art and literary display paired with creative family activities. For the past two years, our live event transitioned to a virtual format during the coronavirus pandemic, but we look forward to hosting it in person in 2022.




