— KEY TRANSACTIONS —

- Activated from Injured Reserve/Designated for Return on 12/10/22
- Designated to return from Injured Reserve on 11/23/22
- Placed on Injured Reserve (wrist) on 10/11/22
- Signed a five-year contract with the Ravens on 3/17/22
- Signed a one-year contract extension under the franchise tag with New Orleans on 3/9/21
- Originally selected by the New Orleans Saints in the second round (42nd overall) of the 2017 NFL Draft

— CAREER HIGHLIGHTS —

- Has produced at least 50 tackles and multiple INTs in each of his first six NFL campaigns (2017-22), joining Tyrann Mathieu, Jordan Poyer and Justin Simmons as the only players to reach those marks each season from 2017-22
- Started all 10 in which he appeared in 2022, spending Weeks 6-13 on Injured Reserve (wrist)...Led the defense with a career-high 4 INTs (tied for 11th in NFL) and 8 PD, while adding 61 tackles, 2 TFL and 1 FR...Helped Baltimore's defense rank in the Top 5 in four categories: No. 3 in points allowed per game (18.5), No. 3 in defensive red zone TD% (46.4), No. 3 in rushing yards per game (92.1) and No. 4 in third-down efficiency (34.9%)
- Recorded a game-high 10 tackles (7 solo) and 2 INTs, marking his second-career multi-INT game and the first since his 2017 campaign, vs. Mia. (9/18/22)...Became the first Raven in franchise history to produce 3 INTs in the first two games of a season...Notched his second-straight game with 10-plus tackles and an INT, becoming the ninth NFL player (third Raven – Daryl Smith, 2013; Ray Lewis, 2003) and second NFL DB (George Wilson, 2011) since at least 2000 (when data became available) to accomplish this feat
- Spent the first five years (2017-21) of his career with New Orleans, starting in every game in which he appeared (76), totaling 311 tackles (231 solo), 15 INTs (1 pick-6), 38 PD, 1 sack, 3 FFs and 1 FR
- Started 16 games at safety in 2021, recording a career-high 74 tackles (52 solo), 2 INTs, 8 PD and 1 FF for a Saints defense that finished seventh in yards allowed per game (318.2 ypg) and fourth in points allowed per game (19.7 ppg)

- Helped New Orleans earn a postseason berth in each of his first four seasons with the team (2017-20), including an appearance in the NFC Championship game in 2018...In seven postseason games (all starts), has recorded 38 tackles (24 solo), 1 INT and 3 PD
- Earned *PFWA* All-Rookie team honors in 2017 after posting 71 tackles (56 solo), 7 PD and 4 INTs...Tied for third in tackles (71) and second in INTs (4) among rookie DBs

— PERSONAL —

- Is an avid gamer and enjoys fishing
- Is the youngest of four boys
- Twice in 2020, won the NFL's "Way to Play" award which features fundamentally sound big plays, awarding him with \$5,000 in equipment grants to benefit youth football programs of his choice

— 2023 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS —

- Started all 11 games in which he appeared, registering 55 tackles, 1 TFL, 1 INT and 8 PD...Helped the Ravens' defense become the first unit in NFL history to lead the league in scoring (16.5), sacks (60) and takeaways (31)
- Posted 3 total tackles and 1 PD in the AFC Championship vs. KC (1/28/24), helping hold the Chiefs to just 98 total yards and zero points in the second half
- Notched a season-high 9 tackles (3 solo) and 1 PD vs. Pit. (1/6) for a Ravens' defense that allowed just 134 yards passing
- Recorded 5 tackles (4 solo) in the 56-19 victory vs. Mia. (12/31)...Baltimore's defense posted 3 takeaways, 3 sacks and limited the Dolphins' No. 1 scoring offense to just 19 points
- Posted 7 tackles (5 solo), including 1 TFL, and the fourth-down game-sealing INT in the 33-19 victory at SF (12/25)...Baltimore tied a single-game franchise record with 5 INTs (10/14/07 vs. STL)
- Contributed 5 tackles (4 solo) – including an in-bounds, point-saving tackle on the Ravens' 5-yard line as time expired in the first half – in the 23-7 win at Jax. (12/17)...Baltimore limited the Jaguars to 3-of-13 (23.1%) on third down
- Recorded a season-high 7 tackles (5 solo) and 2 PD in the 34-20 win vs. Cin. (11/16), helping the defense hold the Bengals to 2-of-11 (18.2%) on third down
