


Goal 7 of the Sustainable Development Goals:


Ensure access to affordable, reliable, sustainable and modern energy for all.





In 17 countries, less than 50% of households with persons with disabilities have access to electricity

In **37 out of 44** countries, households with persons with disabilities had **lower** access to electricity than those without persons with disabilities




Persons with disabilities are more exposed to detrimental air pollution resulting from the use of traditional forms of energy

The wood and coal are used for cooking in 66% of households with persons with disabilities in rural areas compared to only 32% of those in urban areas

Households Cooking with Wood or Coal


