NON-HOMESTEAD MILLAGE RENEWAL PROPOSITION FOR OPERATION

Shall the limitation on the amount of taxes which may be assessed against non-homestead property in Grasslake Community School District, Jackson, Washtenaw Counties, Michigan, be increased by eighteen (18) mills (\$18.00 on each \$1,000) on state equalized valuation for three (20) years, 1994 through 2013, inclusive, to provide additional funds for operating purposes (this being partial renewal of 30.2 mills for operating purposes which expired with 1993 tax levy)?

(Passage of this proposition will enable the District to levy 18 mills on non-homestead property in 1994 and in years 1995 through 1996, subject to possible reduction pursuant to the Headlee Amendment, Michigan State Constitution of 1963, as amended).

(If this proposal is approved, and the District levies 18 mills on non-homestead property, as required by Michigan Public Act 312 of 1993, the revenue increase in 1994 to be realized from the portion of such levy authorized by the passage of this proposal will be approximately \$442,154.)


