15 **JUDGMENT**

16 THIS MATTER came on regularly before the undersigned judge of the above-entitled  
17 Court. The Plaintiff, State of Washington, by and through its attorneys of record, ROBERT M.  
18 MCKENNA, Attorney General, LINDA A. DALTON, Senior Assistant Attorney General, and  
19 H. BRUCE MARVIN, Assistant Attorney General, and the Defendants named above, by and  
20 through their respective attorneys of record, C. JAMES FRUSH and SALLY GUSTAFSON  
21 GARRATT, Attorneys at Law, have apprised the Court of their agreement to the entry of this  
22 Judgment for the purpose of settling and compromising this action brought under  
23 RCW 42.17.400.

24 The Defendants acknowledge as follows: 1) The mandate of RCW 42.17 in ensuring  
25 full disclosure of campaign finances is of tantamount importance to fair elections and an  
26 informed electorate; 2) where persons contribute to or otherwise expend monies to further

1 political or campaign activities, those contributions or expenditures must be disclosed to the  
2 public in accordance with RCW 42.17; and 3) when a group of persons pool funds for the  
3 purpose of supporting or opposing a candidate or ballot measure, that group becomes a  
4 political committee with an obligation to file and report their activities pursuant to RCW 42.17.

5 The terms of the parties' agreement include civil penalties and injunctive relief for their  
6 violations of the provisions of chapter 42.17 RCW. The Court, having reviewed the records  
7 and files herein, and having found the agreement to be a just and proper resolution of this  
8 matter, and being otherwise fully advised in the premises, now, therefore:

9 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Defendants, TME  
10 CAPITAL GROUP, LLC and ENVIRONMENTAL MATERIALS TRANSPORT, LLC are  
11 hereby assessed a civil penalty, jointly and severally, for their violations of chapter 42.17  
12 RCW, in the amount of One Hundred and Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$125,000) to be  
13 paid by November 9, 2007.

14 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Defendants Elling Halvorson, Catherine Boshaw,  
15 Doug Edlund, John Taylor, Lon Halvorson, E. Kent Halvorson, Tim Teteak, David Chevalier,  
16 Henry Hopkins, and Monarch Enterprises, Inc. are hereby dismissed from this lawsuit with  
17 prejudice and without assignment of penalty or costs and fees.

18 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Defendants TME CAPITAL GROUP, LLC and  
19 ENVIRONMENTAL MATERIALS TRANSPORT, LLC shall file any and all reports  
20 necessary to register as political committees and properly account for all contributions and  
21 expenditures made by TME and EMT for all times relevant to the subject matter of the  
22 complaint. Such reports shall be reviewed and signed by John Taylor on behalf of TME  
23 CAPITAL GROUP, LLC and Henry Hopkins on behalf of ENVIRONMENTAL  
24 MATERIALS TRANSPORT, LLC, and shall be filed no later than sixty (60) days from the  
25 date of this judgment.  
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
1 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Defendants, TME CAPITAL GROUP, LLC and  
2 ENVIRONMENTAL MATERIALS TRANSPORT, LLC are hereby assessed costs and fees,  
3 under the provisions of RCW 42.17.400, in the amount of Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000)  
4 to be paid by November 9, 2007.




