THE MATCHUP

- > Arkansas and Denver will meet for the 11th time in program history with Denver taking the top spot in seven of the previous ten meetings. The Razorbacks and Pioneers split the last two meetings, Arkansas defeated Denver in Fayetteville, 197.300-196.725 on March. 16, 2018.
- > Took first place in the collegiate challenge (Jan. 4) with a score of 196.700 and scored a 196.750 in its home opener to top visiting Minnesota (196.475) on Sunday (Jan. 12).
- > So. Alexis Vasquez (Arcadia, Calif.) collected her second consecutive Big 12 Conference Event Specialist of the Week award scoring a near-perfect 9.975 on beam during Denver's home opener on Jan. 12 against Minnesota. It was a follow-up to her perfect 10.0 in the team's Jan. 4 season opener.

NOTES

- > Arkansas will host five teams at Barnhill Arena over the course of the 2020 season, beginning with Denver on Friday, Jan. 17, at 7 p.m. The Gymbacks will also square off with Kentucky (Jan. 24), Georgia (Feb. 7), Auburn (Feb. 21) and Penn State (March 13) as part of their home slate.
- > Arkansas gymnastics began the year ranked 19th by the Women's Collegiate Gymnastics Association (WCGA). It marks the 14th consecutive year the Gymbacks have been ranked in the top 20 in the debut rankings. Last season, Arkansas started the year at No. 12 and climbed as high as 10th in the WCGA poll.
- > The Arkansas gymnastics team finished third at the NCAA Baton Rouge Regional Second Round Semifinal I, falling to second place finisher Minnesota by 0.125. Senior Hailey Garner and Junior Sophia Carter went one to compete individually on beam and floor respectively but did not advance past the SII session in Fort Worth.
- > Friday's meet at Florida opened the head coaching career of Arkansas' Jordyn Wieber. A member of the U.S.'s gold medal team at the 2012 Olympics and 2011 World all-around champion, Wieber served as team manager at UCLA for three seasons and was the Bruins volunteer coach the last three seasons. The Bruins advanced to the NCAA team final each of the last four seasons, winning the 2018 NCAA Championship. She replaced Mark Cook, who led the Razorbacks from the program's first season in 2003 until his retirement at the conclusion of the 2019 season.

WCGA Scholastic All-Americans

Ten members of the Arkansas gymnastics team have been recognized as 2018-19 Scholastic All-Americans by the Women's Collegiate Gymnastics Association (WCGA). Arkansas' 10 honorees matches its highest total of scholar athletes in program history, also reaching 10 in 2015. The Razorbacks were one of 31 teams with more than 56 percent of student-athletes on their teams with a 3.5 grade point average or higher and one of three in the SEC, checking in with a clip of 66.7 percent. The 10 Scholastic All-Americans include: Makenzie Anderson, Sophia Carter, Amanda Elswick, Kailey Gillings, Kennedy Hambrick, Sydney Laird, Bailey Lovett, Sydney McGlone, Kirby Rathjen and Jessica Yamzon. It's the second honor for Anderson (2017), Carter (2018) and Laird (2018).

Razorbacks Place First, Set Another School Record
March 16, 2018

FAYETTEVILLE, Ark. - The 11th-ranked Arkansas gymnastics team took first at the Arkansas Tri meet, topping 15th-ranked Denver and 26th-ranked Iowa State, en route to another school record score of 197.300.

Senior Braie Speed anchored Arkansas' first rotation and tallied a 9.900 to lead the Razorbacks. It's her third 9.900 or higher in four meets on the event, as she has not scored under a 9.850 all season. Senior Amanda Wellick and freshman Sarah Shaffer recorded a 9.825 each as the Razorbacks posted a 49.025 on vault, putting Arkansas in second place through one.

"I have no words for tonight," said Speed. "Tonight was the best senior night this class could ever have. I'm so proud of this team and couldn't ask for a better group of girls to have this year with."

Second Rotation: Arkansas Bars: 49.550, Iowa State Floor: 49.325, Denver Beam: 49.025

In the anchor spot, sophomore Hailey Garner set a new school mark with a 9.975 on the event. Speed tied the previous record with a 9.950 as Wellick and freshman Sydney Laird recorded 9.900's each to give Arkansas a 49.550. The score is the second highest team score in team history on the event, as the Razorbacks have now scored a 49.450 or higher three times this season on bars. The Razorbacks took a lead it never relinquished in the second rotation, leading Denver by one-tenth through two.

Third Rotation: Arkansas Beam: 49.350, Denver Floor: 49.175, Iowa State Vault: 48.900

Arkansas' three anchors in freshman Sophia Carter, freshman Sarah Shaffer and sophomore Michaela Burton recorded scores of 9.900 each to lead Arkansas to a 49.350 on beam. The score for Shaffer was her first 9.900 on the event since Feb. 2 against Alabama and ties her career high. Sophomore Jessica Yamzon posted a 9.850 as Garner and Wellick each recorded 9.800's to round out Arkansas scoring on the event. The Razorbacks held a 0.175 lead over Denver through three rotations.

Fourth Rotation: Arkansas Floor: 49.375, Iowa State Bars: 49.075, Denver Vault: 48.975

Following a pair of low scores to begin the rotation the Razorbacks needed big scores from its final four competitors in the rotation. Arkansas got just that with four scores over 9.800 including three of 9.900 or higher. Shaffer set a new career high with a 9.950 while Carter anchored the rotation with a 9.900.

Shaffer set a new career high in the all-around with a 39.500 while Yamzon and Wellick posted a 39.275 and a 39.225 respectively.

JORDYN WIEBER HEAD COACH, 1ST SEASON

Olympic gold medalist Jordyn Wieber was introduced as the head coach of the Arkansas Women's Gymnastics program on Wednesday, April 24, 2019, by Vice Chancellor and Director of Athletics Hunter Yurachek.

Wieber is a familiar name in the gymnastics community after a prolific career as a competitor, including earning a gold medal as part of Team USA in the 2012

Olympics. Since finishing her competitive career, Wieber has served as an assistant for legendary UCLA coach Valorie Kondos Field, helping lead the Bruins to the 2018 NCAA Championship. Beyond the gym, Wieber has served as an outspoken advocate for victims of child sexual abuse. Wieber has used the platform of gymnastics to encourage and inspire generations of young girls and others around the nation.

Wieber recently wrapped up her third season as a volunteer assistant coach at UCLA and her sixth with the program, assisting the team in a variety of roles during her first three years in Westwood following her Olympic career.

Wieber coached the Bruins on floor exercise, an event in which UCLA finished the 2018 and 2019 regular seasons ranked No. 1 in the nation. In 2019, the Bruins recorded scores of 49.5 or better in 11 of 14 meets, averaging a national-best 49.604 on floor. UCLA hit a season-high 49.825 on March 16, which ranks No. 3 all-time in school history, behind five scores of 9.925 or better in that meet, including two perfect 10s. The floor squad also posted marks of 49.775 (March 23) and 49.750 (Feb. 16) over the course of the year, as four Bruins earned regular season All-America honors in the event - Katelyn Ohashi, Kyla Ross, Gracie Kramer and Felicia Hano.

At the NCAA Championships on April 19-20, Wieber coached Ross to the individual floor title with a score of 9.950, the program's second in as many years after Ohashi took home the crown in 2018. After winning their semifinal session with a 197.650 (49.6125 in the floor), UCLA finished third overall in the finals.

The 2018 Bruins scored 49.4 or higher in 11 meets and 49.6 or higher in three meets, including a national season-high of 49.775 set Feb. 25. She and her fellow UCLA coaches were named the 2018 West Region Assistant Coaches of the Year, as

they helped lead the Bruins to Pac-12, NCAA regional and NCAA national titles.

Wieber, who has been a vocal advocate for safe sport, has won several awards in the past year, including the Arthur Ashe Courage Award at the ESPYs, the Rising Star Award by the Los Angeles Business Journal, and the Giant Steps A Hero Among Us Award.

A member of the "Fierce Five" United States squad that won team gold at the 2012 Olympics, Wieber was a two-time U.S. all-around champion (2011 and 2012) and the 2011 World all-around champion. Her illustrious Elite Career included three medals (all-around and team gold, beam bronze) at the 2011 World Championships, four U.S. senior national titles (all-around, bars and floor in 2011 and all-around in 2012). She was also the 2008 U.S. junior all-around, vault and floor exercise champion and the American Cup all-around champion in 2009, 2011 and 2012. She dominated the competition at the 2010 Pacific Rim Championships, winning four gold medals (all-around, uneven bars, floor exercise, team) and one silver (vault). In her first international competition at the 2007 Junior Pan American Championships, she won gold medals on uneven bars and balance beam, silver in the all-around and bronze on floor exercise. Wieber officially retired from competitive gymnastics in 2015.

Wieber, from DeWitt, Mich., graduated from UCLA in 2017 with a degree in Psychology. She was a 2016 inductee into the Greater Lansing Sports Hall of Fame and is also a member of the USA Gymnastics Hall of Fame as a member of the 2012 U.S. Olympic team.

GYMBACK SPEED CHART



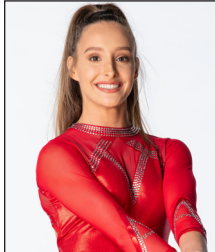
