WHAT IS TELPAS?

Who?

Students in grades K–12 who have been identified as an EB student

What?

TELPAS is an assessment program for EB students in Texas public schools who are learning the English language. The letters TELPAS stand for the Texas English Language Proficiency Assessment System.

When?

TELPAS tests are given in the spring during a six-week administration window.

Why?

TELPAS tests are designed to measure the progress that each EB student makes in becoming proficient in the use of academic English.

How?

For students in kindergarten and grade 1, trained teachers evaluate students through classroom observations. Students in grades 2–12 take TELPAS online assessments.
