Feb 22

Feb 22 **Russia invades Ukraine** and highlights Europe's need to **pivot away from Russian gas** reliance once and for all, pushing EU member states to accelerate the **energy transition**.

Feb 22 We publish **Poland's Energy Dilemma**, a report analysing Poland's transition in energy production from coal into gas power to bring down emissions.

Mar 22

Mar 22 Landmark proposal ruled by **SEC to disclose climate risks to investors** in their filings following our **Flying Blind analysis**.

Mar 22 IEA analysis for 2021 finds that **CO<sub>2</sub> rebounds highest level in history** and more than offsets 2020 pandemic decline.

Apr 22

Apr 22 **UK Government** introduces **mandatory climate risk disclosures** for some large businesses and financial firms.

Apr 22 We publish our report **Stop Fueling Uncertainty** exploring the long-term **risks** associated with investment in **power sector gas infrastructure** globally.

May 22

May 22 For the third year running, we publish **Absolute Impact**, assessing and **ranking the climate policies** of 15 of the largest publicly traded **oil and gas companies**.

May 22 **Shell publishes its first Energy Transition progress report** which lacks absolute emissions scope 3 interim targets.

Apr 22

Apr 22 **Saudi Aramco** published its first ever Sustainability Report, containing details of its **"net zero by 2050" target**.

Jun 22 As part of London Climate Action Week, we launch our report **Unburnable Carbon: Ten Years On**, a decade on from Carbon Tracker's inaugural report.

Jul 22

Jul 22 We launch a series of **coal company profiles** assessing whether the companies are on target to achieve net zero emissions by 2050.

Jul 22 **China** experienced its **worst heat wave** in recorded history. At the same time the **US** had its warmest daily minimums ever recorded.

Aug 22

Aug 22 Carbon Tracker and Planet Tracker provide **comments to ISSB on its Sustainability- and Climate-related Disclosures Drafts**.

Sep 22

Sep 22 **Nord Stream** gas leaks with warning of 'large climate risk'.

Sep 22 Carbon Tracker and GEM launch the **Global Registry of Fossil Fuels**, the first public database of emissions from reserves, production and use during Climate Week New York.

Oct 22

Oct 22 All scenarios within **IEA WEO 2022** now show a **peak or plateau for all fossil fuels**.

Oct 22 We publish **our first journal, The Transition Files** and first analysis on hydrogen: **Clean Hydrogen's Place in the Energy Transition**, exploring green hydrogen's role in the energy transition. **Still Flying Blind** was also launched.

Nov 22 We launch our report **African Sun at COP27**, highlighting the opportunities and challenges to getting all African nations on the path to a new energy era.

Nov 22 The consensus about **COP27 in Sharm El-Sheikh** was one of some **disappointment**, despite some progress on creating a loss & damage fund.

Dec 22

Dec 22 We begin distilling our ground-breaking research into an overarching **Energy Transition newsletter** wrapper.

Dec 22 We publish our **first analysis of the Automotive sector, Slipped Gear**.

Dec 22 Carbon Tracker won as **NGO of the Year** in the **Environmental Finance's Impact Awards 2022**.
