CBSS Action Plan 2021 - 2025





Introduction

In accordance with the CBSS Reforms agreed in the 2020 Bornholm Declaration, and the three CBSS long-term priorities - Regional Identity, Safe & Secure Region and Sustainable & Prosperous Region¹ - CBSS will focus on delivering concrete results in areas in which CBSS cooperation is uniquely suited to add value, including in a reinforced cooperation with other international fora and formats active in the Baltic Sea region.

The actions covered by this Action Plan will contribute to the realization of objectives of the Vilnius II Declaration and the CBSS goals and objectives as decided by the Council on 20 June 2014. The Action Plan will cover activities during the period 2021–2025.

The list of actions included in this Plan will be reviewed by the CSO on a regular basis and, if necessary, updated with new actions deemed necessary to fulfil objectives of the Action Plan. A report on the implementation of the Action Plan will be presented in 2025.




Actions will focus on fostering active and meaningful participation by young people nurturing a shared regional identity and an enhanced sense of belonging to the Baltic Sea region.

Regional Identity of the Baltic Sea Region should be built on close collaboration and complementarity between regional actors and networks, inter alia among the 4 sister Councils of the North (CBSS, Arctic Council, Barents Euro-Arctic Council, Nordic Council of Ministers), and the Northern Dimension and its four partnerships.
