



It's a wrap!

During the 10th European Summit of Regions and Cities held in Mons, Belgium, over 3,000 local and regional leaders from 59 countries and all 5 continents gathered to influence policy ahead of EU elections and a crucial European Council meeting. The 'Mons Declaration', presented to Belgian Prime Minister Alexander De Croo, calls for increased public investment, local solutions for achieving climate goals, and active participation of regional authorities in EU reforms and enlargement processes.

The 10th European Summit of Regions and cities also marked the 30th anniversary of the European Committee of the Regions (CoR).

In total 83 YEPs participated in the Summit while attending meetings with their political groups and study visits.

In the dedicated stand for YEPs in coordination with the EU Councillors, they received more information about the new call for applications and on how to spread the word in their networks for more charismatic young leaders to join our community.

This year is a crucial one, as local and regional elections are happening across Europe and the European Parliament elections are just around the corner.

Tο accommodate young representatives from countries with local and regional elections, the call has now been extended until 14 June 2024 for applicants from Belgium, Cyprus, Hungary, Ireland, Latvia, Malta, Poland, Romania and from candidate countries for EU accession (Albania, Moldova, North Macedonia, Montenegro, Serbia, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Türkiye, Ukraine and Georgia).

22nd ENVE Commission meeting

Our YEP Julia Polley (DE/EPP), City Councillor of Bonn, intervened in the 22nd meeting of the Commission for Environment, Climate Change and Energy (ENVE) which took place on 11 April 2024 in Brussels.

In the exchange of views of the opinion on "What is the role of regional and local authorities in the transition towards a circular economy?", Ms Polley talked about not just recycling but minimising waste production. She highlighted a recycling plant integrated with a power station for efficient energy use in Bonn and stressed the importance of public participation.
