MPA Graduation Rates

The MPA degree is designed to be a two-year (four semesters in total) program for a full-time student. 106 students were enrolled in the MPA program this current academic year. However, approximately 60% of our students are working during their studies and take fewer classes each term, and thus take longer to graduate.

- Of students who matriculated in the 2013-14 academic year, 93.44 percent of students completed the program in four years. Among those who completed, 54.39 percent completed in two years, 24.56 percent completed in three years, and 21.05 percent completed in four years.
- Of students who matriculated in the 2014-15 academic year, 79.25 percent of students completed the program in four years. Among those who completed, 28.57 percent completed in two years, 61.90 percent completed in three years, and 9.52 percent completed in four years.
