

## MPA Graduation Rates and Job Placement

The following data is from the AY 2023-2024 NASPAA Annual Maintenance Report (submitted October 2024). The data is for the AY 2018-2019 MPA Cohort.

The MPA degree is designed to be a two-year (five semesters in total) program for a full-time student. However, approximately 55% of our students are working during their studies and take fewer classes each term, and thus take longer to graduate.

Of 53 students who matriculated in the 2018-2019 academic year, 40 students (75.47 percent) completed the program in four years. Among those who completed, 30 students (56.60 percent) completed in two years, 9 students (16.98 percent) completed in three years, and 1 student (1.89 percent) completed in four years.
