

MAKING ADJUSTMENTS

ADJUSTABLE / NO ELECTRONICS



ACETATE FRAME FRONT

Heat okay for lens insertion and nose bridge adjustments.



NO HEAT ON TEMPLES



TEMPLE TIPS ADJUSTMENTS

Hold firmly on the metal accent near the temple tips with one hand and adjust with the other hand.

DO NOT ADJUST WITH PLIERS

Pliers will damage internal sensors.

DO NOT APPLY TILT

Does not support pantoscopic tilt.

FULFILLING LENSES

PRESCRIPTION RANGE



Determine appropriate prescription as you would with acetate frames. Our suggested prescription range (spherical equivalent) covers: -8.00 to +4.00. We recommend high index lenses for prescriptions of -5.00 or higher.

CLEANING SMART GLASSES

NO ULTRASONIC CLEANERS Do not submerge smart glasses, clean the device with a soft, dry cloth.



EDGE / INSERT / REMOVE

Edge, insert, and remove lenses as you would with acetate frames.



NO ALCOHOL SOLUTIONS ON SMART GLASSES

To remove ink from lenses only, apply isopropyl alcohol (70% max) with caution.



HOT OR COLD MOUNT OK

Frame front lens insertion, apply heat as needed at optician's discretion.



SPLASH RESISTANT (IPX4 RATING)

Do not rinse under running water.

Worry Free Lens Installation: Your Smart Glasses with Alexa were designed to be compatible with prescription lenses, just like any other acetate frames.
