I would like to welcome you to the upcoming 2015-16 school year at Dallas Center-Grimes School District. It is with great pleasure that I am able to update you on the multiple ways our staff continues to strive toward the model of academic excellence that you have come to expect from us.

Because of this reputation and the success of the Grimes and Dallas Center communities several new families are moving to our district. As new students enroll, we are committed to remaining within the board goals for class size. Our new elementary which will help us manage the growth will be located in the new Heritage development in Grimes. We look forward to opening the building at the start of the 2017-18 school year. The new bus/maintenance facility is nearly completed and will be ready for this school year. We have also met with architects about future additions on the Dallas Center Elementary, updates/renovations on South Prairie Elementary and completion of the baseball/softball complex in Dallas Center. While it can be a challenge to stay ahead of the growth, we consider it an exciting opportunity to welcome new families while still maintaining our small school feel that people of DCG have come to expect.

The incredible success of our fine arts and athletic programs this past year are reflective of this same type of drive towards excellence. Not only are our students finding great success in competitions, but also, their positive sportsmanship and solid character are indicative of the strong values that our DCG parents and community have instilled in them.

While our growth and extra curricular successes add to our overall state of excellence, we understand that student learning is our greatest priority. Therefore, we are committed to using the District Educational Model to focus and guide our practice. The structure of the triangle provides our non-negotiable beliefs on how we operate at Dallas Center-Grimes. We will have a collaborative culture, a tight focus on learning, and be results-oriented in everything we do. Our collaborative culture was evident throughout the early out and professional development days this past year. This time was dedicated for learning teams to work on curriculum, instruction and assessment. Additionally, every teacher regularly participated in a learning team with their colleagues during the school day. This summer, several teachers participated in the Professional Learning Community (PLC) Conference held in St. Louis. Teachers also spent time this summer meeting with one another, as well as with instructional coaches, PLC Leaders and building leaders. These types of collaboration opportunities will continue to meet our vision of functioning as a professional learning community to ensure ALL students learn.

Our tight focus on learning was evident in a variety of ways last year. At the elementary, teachers researched and implemented a new math program that revolutionizes the way students solve problems. Rather than simply looking for an answer, the children are encouraged to consider why the answer makes sense and how it could be solved in multiple ways. This method requires deeper thought and additional time to process. It also shifts the goal from knowing the answer to truly understanding it.

One example of the focus on learning from the secondary level is the growth of our STEM program (Science, Technology, Engineering and Math). Just last year, we added courses in computer science engineering, programming, and robotics. We have built solid partnerships with area businesses to help us support the kids as they pursue their interests in the STEM areas.

Because we are results-oriented, we look forward to sharing our data with you. Each month I will share information from various grade levels and curricular areas that show you how our students are achieving. It is my goal to keep students, parents, educators and district patrons connected, informed and focused on the high quality of excellence that Dallas Center-Grimes provides for our children. I hope you will take the opportunity to visit our schools and witness first-hand the high quality of education that we are providing. Dallas Center-Grimes Community School Gym Request Form

- All requests should be 60 minutes in length or less and there should only be one request per week. NO GYM SPACE WILL BE RESERVED PRIOR TO OCTOBER 6th.**
- Requests received prior to September 15, 2015 will be given equal preference. Requests received after September 15, 2015 will be given consideration as they are received.
- The gym must be used for the purpose intended on the application.
- Those using the gym should be groups consisting of DC-G students or patrons.
- Groups wishing to use the gym on weekends or non-school days **must have a DC-G employee to open and close the building and that employee must be present at all times** during the activity.
- On week days, when school is not in session or dismissed early due to weather conditions, the gyms will not be available.
- Any school practice or function, which may be rescheduled during the year, will take priority over a group that has scheduled the facility.
- Groups involving students must be out of the gyms by 9:00 pm.
- THE GYMS ARE NOT AVAILABLE ON WEDNESDAYS.**
- Groups must leave the facility in the same condition as found.

HEALTH CORNER

Attention Parents of Seventh-Graders

Recent changes in the Iowa Administrative Code regarding immunization requirements for school entry mean that every child enrolling in the seventh grade must have a Tdap to attend school next August.

Please provide a note from your physician indicating the vaccine and date it was administered to the school nurse to be compliant with this new requirement.

The Tdap Vaccine is a combination vaccine that protects against not only against tetanus and diphtheria but also pertussis.

- Tetanus, also known as “lockjaw”, causes painful muscle spasms, usually all over the body including the tightening of the jaw so the person cannot open their mouth or swallow.
- Diphtheria can cause a thick covering in the back of the throat leading to breathing problems, paralysis or heart failure.
- Pertussis, also known as “whooping cough” causes severe coughing spells, vomiting, rib fractures and complications such as pneumonia.

Rules Concerning Administration of Medication at School

These rules and procedures are for dispensing medication to those pupils who must take prescribed medication and/or over the counter drugs during school. NO MEDICATION SHALL BE DISPENSED to any pupil in the Dallas Center-Grimes Community School system unless the following prerequisites are met:

A licensed medical or osteopathic physician or dentist must prescribe the medication. The form, “Request for Administering Prescription Medicine or Over the Counter Drugs or Medicines at School” must be completed and filed at school.

The medicine shall be maintained in the original prescription container which shall be labeled with:

- name of pupil
- name of physician or dentist prescribing medication
- name of medication
- name and address of pharmacy
- directions for use, dosage, time, and route

The medication, while at school, shall be kept in a designated place, in a locked cabinet. When required, refrigeration will be provided. Access to the medication shall be under the authority of the building principal or a designated person. A written record will be kept on any medication(s) given at school. This record will include the pupil's name, the name of the medication, the amount of medication to be given, and the time at which it is given. After the medication is given, the person dispensing the medication will initial the medication sheet with his/her initials. This record shall be kept each time the medication is given at school, on the appropriate “Medication Record” form. At vacation time, end of school year, or end of dispensing time, any remaining medication needs to be picked up by the parent.

IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS

A completed card needs to be on file on or before the first day of school in order for your child to attend.

Thank you for your assistance and attention to this state requirement. If you have questions or concerns, you may call a school nurse at 986-4057, 992-4343, 986-9747 or 992-3838, 986 5674, or 986-0105.

The following is a list of required immunizations for 2015-16:

HIB: 3 doses with final dose in the series received on or after 12 months of age, or 1 dose received when the applicant is 15 months or older

POLIO: at least four doses of polio vaccine with one dose being received after the child's 4th birthday.

DTP/DTaP: at least five doses of diphtheria, tetanus, pertussis with one dose being received after the child's 4th birthday.

Tdap: one dose if enrolling in 7th grade

MEASLES/RUBELLA: two doses of measles and rubella. The first dose shall have been received on or after 12 months of age. The second dose of measles and rubella vaccine shall have been received no less than 30 days after the first dose.

HEPATITIS B: three doses of hepatitis B vaccine prior to enrollment.

VARICELLA: two doses received on or after 12 months of age if born on or after September 15, 2003 OR a history of natural disease as stated by parent or guardian is required.

Reporting Absences

Regular attendance is a very important part of education. If your child is ill, please call the school secretary before 9:00 a.m. Your calls are most appreciated because if your student is absent and the school has not been notified, efforts will be made to contact parents. If the illness is more than one day, please call the school each day: South Prairie Elementary at 986-4057, Dallas Center Elementary Building at 992-3838, North Ridge Elementary 986-5674, DC-G Middle School 992-4343, The Meadows at 986-0105 and DC-G High School 986-9747.

If your child is absent due to illness, please send a note to school when he/she returns describing the illness, so that we may clearly identify the health problems of our school. If you are uncertain as to the length of time to keep your child at home, please contact the school nurse.

First Day of School at the High School

On the first day of school, Monday, August 24, all high school students will meet in the auditorium for an assembly at 8:10 a.m. Students will then be dismissed to their advisory teachers. The most current schedule will be handed out during advisory. School will be in session the entire day.

There will be no late arrival for eligible juniors and seniors on the first day of school. In addition, students and parents must sign the release form and have it on file prior to this privilege being granted. These forms were sent out in the registration packet. Forms can also be picked up in the high school office, both prior to the start of school and once school begins.

Driving and Parking at the High School

All seniors will park in the South Lot, in the front of the building. All junior and sophomore drivers will park in the North Lot near the stadium.

All students are to register their vehicles in the office. A \$5 charge for a parking hangtag is required yearly. All vehicles that are driven to the school must be registered. Registration is also available through the school registration process. This hangtag is to be hung from the rear-view mirror of the vehicle, and easily observable.

If a different vehicle is driven, simply transfer the hangtag to the car driven that particular day.

All cars must be parked correctly, with no double-parking or “pulling through” parking stalls, facing the wrong way.

School Bus Service

The District provides transportation to students that qualify. School bus stops are determined by grade and by distances students live from their school. Elementary students who live more than two miles from their school qualify for school bus transportation. High School students who live more than three miles from their school qualify for school bus transportation.



Parents are encouraged to utilize school bus service for their children as much as possible. School buses transportation is safer, less expensive, and reduces the traffic congestion at the schools.

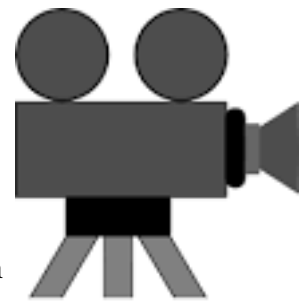
School Transportation Coordinating Instructions:

1. School bus routes are posted on the school web page at www.dcgsschools.com under the TRANSPORTATION tab. Check for updates to the route schedules a week before school starts in case there are any changes.
2. Students requiring special transportation or home pickup will be individually called by the school bus driver by Thursday, August 20.
3. Each bus has a black & white route number sign on the right side of the bus school bus. There are multiple buses using each bus stop so make sure your child is using the correct bus to their school.
4. We have found that children become more comfortable with the bus and bus rules if they ride both ways for the first few days.
5. We would like parents' assistance in giving the transported kindergarten students the best start possible for their bus ride experience. To assure a smooth beginning, please review the following suggestions:
 - Escort your child to the bus STOP the **first** day of school and follow in a car to meet your child as they get off the bus and walk them into the building.
 - The district does not require parents of Kindergarten students to meet the bus on a daily basis throughout the year, but we certainly encourage it.

Bus Video Cameras

The school board has authorized the use of video cameras on Dallas Center – Grimes School District school buses. The video cameras will be used to monitor student behavior in order to promote and maintain a safe environment. Bus camera video may be used in student disciplinary proceedings. Video will be retained only if necessary for use in student disciplinary proceedings or other matters as determined by the administration. Parents may request to view video of their child if the video is used in a disciplinary proceeding involving their child.



STOP for school buses when alternating lights are flashing
Whenever you see the alternating flashing red lights on a school bus, you must stop if you are on a two-lane roadway or you are on a multiple-lane roadway and you are traveling in the same direction as the school bus. IF YOU DON'T....the risk of an accident, a ticket, and fines are HIGH. Violators' license plate number will be recorded and sent to the Polk or Dallas County Sheriff. Be SAFE!

SCHOOL BUS SAFETY

School buses across the country transport millions of students every year and are without question the safest way for kids to get to school. We transport around 1,500 students per day at DC-G and our number one priority is “SAFETY”. Transporting kids to and from school takes a team effort to be successful. Parents, students, and the school all need to work together to provide the safest transportation possible.

Parents Responsibilities:

1. Ensure your child arrives at their bus STOP safely and on time.
2. During extreme weather, ensure your child boards the bus safely because times may vary.
3. Review the Bus Rules with your child.

Bus Driver and School Responsibilities:

1. Ensure the school bus is safe to transport students.
2. Ensure buses run on schedule.
3. Ensure there are enough seats on each bus to transport students safely.
4. Ensure all students are safely transported to and from school.

Student’s Responsibilities:

LOADING PROCEDURE SAFETY

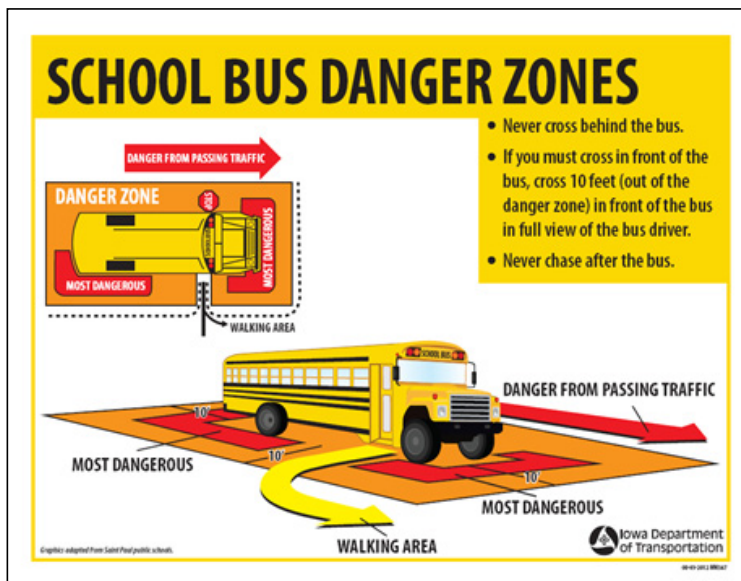
1. Be at the bus stop no later than 5 minutes prior to bus scheduled time.
2. Stand in line quietly at the stop or school.
3. Use safe crossing procedures. Wait for “Thumbs UP before crossing the street in front of a school bus”.

SEATING ON THE BUS/SAFETY

4. Follow direction of driver as to where and how to sit safely on the bus. To avoid discipline problems, students may be assigned seats on the bus.
5. Talk quietly and keep hands to them self.
6. Understand the importance of the driver’s need to keep their eyes on the road.

UNLOADING SAFETY

7. Remain seated until the bus stops.
8. Leave the bus in single file, without shoving or pushing.
9. Use caution around the school bus **DANGER ZONE**
10. Follow **ALL** of the bus safety rules.



WHAT IS THE DANGER ZONE?

The Danger Zone is the space all around the school bus. It extends out 10 feet in all directions.

The School Bus Driver cannot see you in this zone. He or she cannot see you around the wheels either. It is very dangerous to be in the Danger Zone.

If you have to cross the road:

- Make eye contact with the driver.
- Wait for the driver to signal you when it is safe to cross.
- Be sure it is safe - Look left, right, then left again.
- **NEVER CROSS BEHIND THE BUS.**

Driver's Education for Dallas-Center Grimes High School and Middle School for 2015-2016

We will continue to offer four sessions of driver's education each year if there is enough interest. Please call the Meadows school office at 986-0105 to sign your child up for any of these programs. The cost is \$325 for students living within the district. Cost for out-of-district students is \$375. Students must be at least 14 years old and have a permit to sign-up, as well as a signed parent permission slip. Eighth through twelfth-graders may sign-up for each session. If the class fills up during the year with 9-12-graders the 8th-graders will be on a waiting list. If your child does not get in, they will be able to sign-up for the next upcoming session. Usually the fall session is the busiest. Below you will find information about each session.

Fall Session 2015--The fall program will begin in mid-October and end before winter break in December. There will be a meeting in early October to hand out information and collect payment if necessary. Please pay ahead if possible. Classroom days are Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday from 6:45 to 8:00 a.m. Most students will drive during study hall times. If this can't be worked out, before or after school driving may be arranged. All students who drive during study halls will drive at least one Saturday for 2 hours downtown Des Moines. Shuttle bus service from Dallas Center will also be available in the morning to bring students in early for classroom. Class size is limited to 40 students. Home-schooled students are welcome.

Winter Session 2016---The winter program will begin in January and end before spring break in March. There will be a meeting in December to hand out information and collect payment. Classroom days are Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday from 6:45 to 8:00 a.m. Most students will drive during their study hall times. If this can't be worked out, before or after school times may be arranged. All students who drive during study halls will drive at least one Saturday

for 2 hours downtown Des Moines. Shuttle bus service from Dallas Center will also be available in the morning to bring students to their classroom time. Class size is limited to 40 students. Home-schooled students are welcome.

Spring Session 2016---The spring program will begin after spring break and end in May. There will be a meeting before spring break to hand out information and collect payment. Classroom days are Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday from 6:45 to 8:00 a.m. Most students will drive during their study hall times. If this can't be worked out, before or after school driving may be arranged. All students who drive during study halls will drive at least one Saturday for 2 hours downtown Des Moines. Shuttle bus service from Dallas Center will also be available in the morning to bring students in early for classroom work. Class size is limited to 40 students. Home-schooled students are welcome.

Summer Session 2016---Our summer program is held during the months of June and July. We may have a final meeting in May to collect permission slips and payment. Class time will begin Monday, June 1 and end on Friday, June 19. Classes will

be every day for the first three weeks from 7:00-9:00 a.m. Driving times will be (6) two-hour periods with a driving partner. (Example, a student might drive from 9-11:00 a.m. on a Monday). Driving times will be scheduled until 5:00 p.m. and may also be on a Saturday. If you live in Grimes, your child may be picked up at a central location such as Casey's, the True Value, or Kum and Go, and then be dropped off at same location when driving lesson is finished. This needs to be prearranged with the instructor. Driving groups will be able to change times with other groups if necessary. Students will draw numbers for driving times. Class limit will be 48 students. Home-schooled students are welcome.

All payments and permission slips should be made or turned in before the first classroom. Payment plans may be arranged with the Meadows office.
