

STEP 4. Receive Your Letter of Acceptance

If your application is successful, you will receive an official Letter of Acceptance from DEA Canadian College.

Step 5: Apply for Your Study Permit

Apply for a study permit or a Co-op work permit, if needed.

INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

STUDY PERMIT

If you plan to study in Canada for more than six months, you will need a permit. Additionally, an entry visa may be required for most countries.

Before applying for a study permit, ensure you have:

- An official Letter of Acceptance from DEA Canadian College, including our DLI number.
- Proof of financial support for tuition fees and living expenses
- A medical exam, if required.
- Biometrics, if required.

CO-OP WORK PERMIT

If your program includes a Co-op or work placement, you must apply for a Co-op Work Permit in addition to your study permit.

Submit your Co-op Work Permit application alongside your study permit application.

This permit allows you to work full-time during the Co-op placement. It must be presented before starting the Co-op component.
