Report of the Secretary-General

1. In document A/CONF.32/7 the Secretary-General submitted to the International Conference the report in which he indicated the status of multilateral agreements in the field of human rights concluded under the auspices of the United Nations, as regards their signatures, ratifications, accessions, or notifications of succession.
2. The present addendum to the report contains information on the status of selected human rights conventions adopted by the International Labour Organisation and by the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization, the texts of which are included in the Conference publication entitled Human Rights, A Compilation of International Instruments of the United Nations (A/CONF.32/4).
