


# Embassy of Egypt: 2022 Yearly Recap





### Egypt-U.S. Launch Working Group on Climate Change

U.S. Special Presidential Envoy for Climate, John Kerry held consultations with Egyptian Minister of Foreign Affairs and COP 27 President Sameh Shoukry, in Cairo. The United States and Egypt recognize the urgency of the challenge posed by climate change and the importance of accelerating global efforts on all aspects of the climate change agenda, in particular the need to limit warming to well below 2 degrees C and pursue efforts to limit it to 1.5 degrees C, and to enhance the global response in support of adaptation to climate impacts.




### 100 Years of Egypt-U.S. Diplomatic Partnership
