1- Egypt Launches Suez Canal Expansion:

On 6 August, 2015, Egyptian President Abdel Fattah El Sisi presided over inaugural ceremonies for the expanded Suez Canal, an \$8.6 billion project financed entirely by the Egyptian people and completed two years ahead of schedule. Heads of state and foreign dignitaries from around the world, including French President Francois Hollande, King Abdullah of Jordan, Swiss Vice President Johann Schneider-Ammann and UK Defense Secretary Michael Fallon, were on hand to celebrate the grand opening of the new 45-mile channel and deepening of the old waterway.
