What a big family Evangelism Explosion is! Despite having to go to four different locations this past summer for the 5th Congress of Nations, we were able to have more nations involved because of it. It was wonderful to have over 100 nations represented, and some nations had over 30 staff members present, making this event attended by 470 staff members.

Why did we gather? It was to dream and vision-cast about fulfilling the Great Commission in our generation. When planning this event, I was nervous that our team might think this vision was too bold. But instead, I was encouraged by the fact that God has been saying the same thing to our team worldwide. Our shared vision led to a time of great and authentic unity.

You would not think we would have such unity, but by the grace of God who has provided us with a focused mission and vision, we do! And these National Directors, Board Members, and staff are not just talking about it—they are out discipling the Church to carry the Gospel to the ends of the earth.

MISSION AMERICA



Fulfilling the Great Commission in this Generation is the theme of Evangelism Explosion's current campaign season. Our USA ministry focus in this campaign is **Mission America.** In 2023, we are pleased to report excellent and steady progress by God's grace.



New materials and models often take time. This is the case regarding our new Faith Talks tool for high school students, which has made **steady progress under Kevin Rariden's leadership.** He will continue to research and develop this tool in 2024, and we look forward to a first draft of this material.



In 2023, we began to identify **key churches that use EE** in their ministries in **commendable ways.** We call these Flagship Churches, and we are working on partnering with them to see how we could expand the multiplication ministry of Christ via EE in other potential Flagship Churches.

Regarding our training events, it is encouraging to see our ethnic ministries in the USA (*Arabic, Chinese, Hispanic, Korean, and Vietnamese*) continue to grow and flourish. Each of these ministries has excellent leadership, and they passionately and expertly train Christians and churches nationwide.



At the end of 2023, we are in the final stages of revising the Share Your Faith Workshops and Equip America (EA) tools. 2024 will see an expanded emphasis on Equip America training, which aims to increase the implementation of all of our other tools in local churches. A few pilot trainings of the revised EA will occur in early 2024, and we anticipate good results going forward.



We are thankful for at least 75 International Field Workers (IFWs) who work together to make the USA ministry possible. That total number represents 16 full-time, 11 part-time, and 48 volunteer IFWs. We pray that in 2024, God will increase the number of full-time workers so that we can accomplish all He has called us to do for His glory in the USA.

About 10 USA delegates were honored to participate in the Americas segment of the 2023 Congress of Nations. The USA's formal sponsoring and welcoming of Belize, El Salvador, and Guyana to the status of Multiplying Nations was a blessing.

Though stories of blessing could be many as a result of not only our training events but also the ongoing ministry of EE in local churches nationwide, this note we received from a pastor's wife in North Carolina would speak for many:

"This is the second time for us to go through the Hope For Kids ministry with many of the same children. As a result, one child rededicated her life to Christ, and another gave her life to Christ. Another child has been reaching out to classmates at school by writing Scriptures for them on little notes."

May God continue to be glorified in 2024 as we build on what has begun and what has been accomplished in 2023 in our USA ministries.

through indigenous National Ministries. We currently have 89 strong National Ministries, which we call Multiplying Nations. Every three years, delegates from those nations gather for our Congress of Nations. Typically, it is a week-long event where we gather in person from all over the world to consider key issues and seek God's direction as we plan for the future.

Challenges with international travel in a post-pandemic world made it clear that we could not gather delegates from all of our 89 National Ministries in one location. In an effort to increase access and participation, we decided to hold the Congress in four different locations around the world over the span of a month. Those gatherings were in the Dominican Republic, Kenya, Finland, and Malaysia.

By the grace of God, we had 470 participants from 100 different nations across the four locations!

DAY 1: TRAINING

We kicked off the Congress with two separate training sessions. One focused on the orientation and development of those who sit on the Boards of our National Ministries. The other was geared toward

our National Ministries staff members who carry out the work worldwide. The training was designed to be transferable so that the leaders in attendance could take what they learned back to their country and train others. Many commented that the training catalyzed the ministry's growth in their nation. One attendee named Simon from Tanzania summed it up succinctly, "The training was so good!"

DAY 2: OUR RESOURCES

A significant part of the deliberation was centered around digital materials. While a transition to digital may seem simple, there is the potential for substantial impact in

many of our nations, especially those who rely on selling printed materials for income. The Congress overwhelmingly agreed that *EE International should develop a digital platform for delivery of materials.*

We also discussed our generational resources and how we might engage and equip young people through adulthood for a lifetime of ministry. A key focus was a new youth curriculum in development called Faith Talks. The announcement was met with much enthusiasm, and we look forward to the impact Faith Talks will have on young people around the world.



DAY 3: OUR TEAM

Leadership development is a priority for EE International as we build the ministry worldwide. One-on-one coaching is vital to that development. During the Congress, we rolled out the Coaching Program that has been developing since the 2019 Congress. We are in the process of training Master Coaches on every continent who will be able to train other coaches as we implement the program throughout our National Ministries.

DAY 4: OUR NATIONS

The Congress wrestled with a critical question: "How many Multiplying Nations do we need to minister effectively in every nation on earth?" A Multiplying Nation is one that has satisfied 12 criteria that are indicators of a well-functioning and mature National Ministry, including the ability to help facilitate ministry outside their nation. Our goal is to minister effectively everywhere, but we realize that not every country has the capacity to become a Multiplying Nation. What a blessing to see national leaders from various nations praying and dreaming about working together to equip and mobilize believers in every nation!



The feedback from the delegates was very positive. We heard repeatedly that all in attendance felt loved and encouraged, and they left equipped and excited for more effective ministry in the coming days.

Rosemary from New Zealand was a first-time Congress participant. After participating in the discussions and gaining insight into the global scope of the ministry, she said, "I gained a much more in-depth understanding of EE International, including how the different parts fit together, the extensive reach of the ministry, and possible future opportunities."

EE4G (EE FOR GENERATIONS)

What started as a ministry for teenagers in Indonesia has exploded all over the world! EE for Generations (EE4G) is now not only impacting Asia but also in Africa, Europe, Latin America, and Oceania. And the results are astounding! In 2023, we saw:

- Young leaders trained in 29 countries
- 95 training events held on 5 continents
- 1,546 teens trained to share their faith and disciple others
- 1,516 professions of faith during training events alone

God has opened the door to opportunities to work with nations, denominations, and local churches to equip young leaders with EE4G. For example, God has opened the door this past year to collaboration with one of Ethiopia's largest evangelical church denominations. The Ethiopian Kale Heywet Church (KHC) has over 7,000 churches and 6.7 million members. In March, we had equipped 48 local church leaders. Each has at least 150 young people under their leadership, so in total, there are 7,500 young people that could be impacted. There are a few of these church leaders who coordinate hundreds of churches. This is the harvest, indeed! All of them were passionate and committed to implementing in their local churches. The translation of the EE4G manual book in Amharic (local language) is available now. We thank God for the many wonders He has done this past year through EE4G!

God provided our worldwide staff with a tremendous year as we gathered for our Congress of Nations, trained new staff, and forged a partnership with a major denomination in a strategic part of the world.



At our Congress of Nations, we dedicated an entire day to training our staff and the members of our

National Boards of Directors in a track tailored specifically for them. We held training sessions for the staff and engaged in lively discussions on EE's mission, vision, values, and goals, assessing ourselves and others, recruitment, and coaching. The Training Day and the Congress itself served as great vehicles for fellowship and morale boosts for all our staff.






16 new full-time staff members were trained in 2023 from 10 nations: Fiji, Finland, India, Laos, Malaysia, New Zealand, Papua New Guinea, Romania, Timor L'Este, and Vanuatu. These new National Directors and Implementation Field Workers all graduated from the month-long training at our D. James Kennedy Training Centre in Fiji. They are now commissioned back to their nations to fulfill the calling God has given them to serve Him through EE.

In Ethiopia, we put 54 denominational leaders through a curriculum similar to our staff training. We trained them in mission, spiritual life, leadership, productivity, and the EE tools of Hope for Kids and EE4G. These Ethiopian Hale Keywet denomination leaders are now set to mobilize their churches, whose members comprise 10% of Ethiopia's population, to train the next generation to share the Gospel effectively to reach Ethiopia, the Horn of Africa, and the world.




