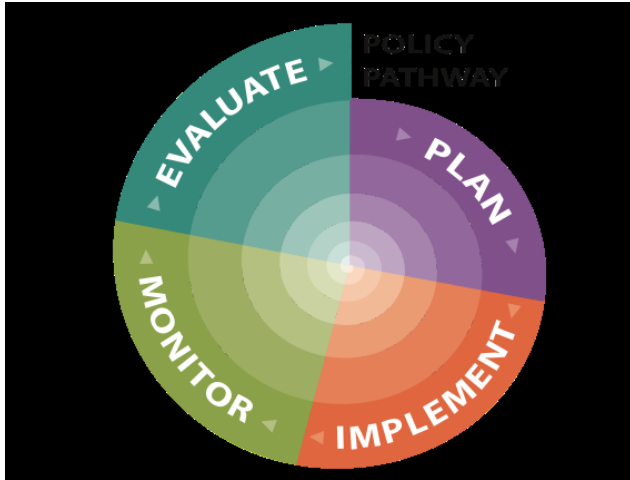

What are the IEA Policy Pathways?



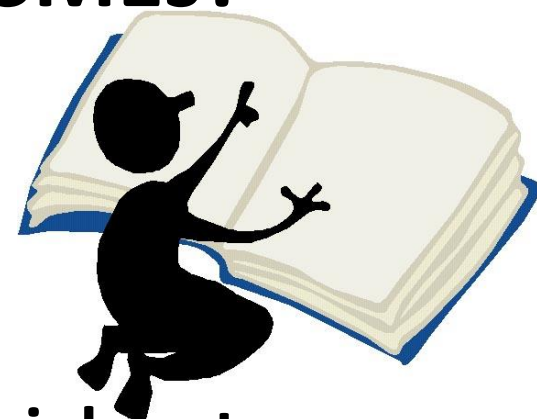
- Actionable guidance for governments and other stakeholders to implement energy efficiency programmes effectively

- “A healthy SME sector contributes prominently to the economy through creating more employment opportunities, generating higher production volumes, increasing exports and introducing innovation and entrepreneurship skills” (US AID 2007)
- This publication is aimed at governments, industry associations, energy utilities, financial institutions, and SMEs themselves

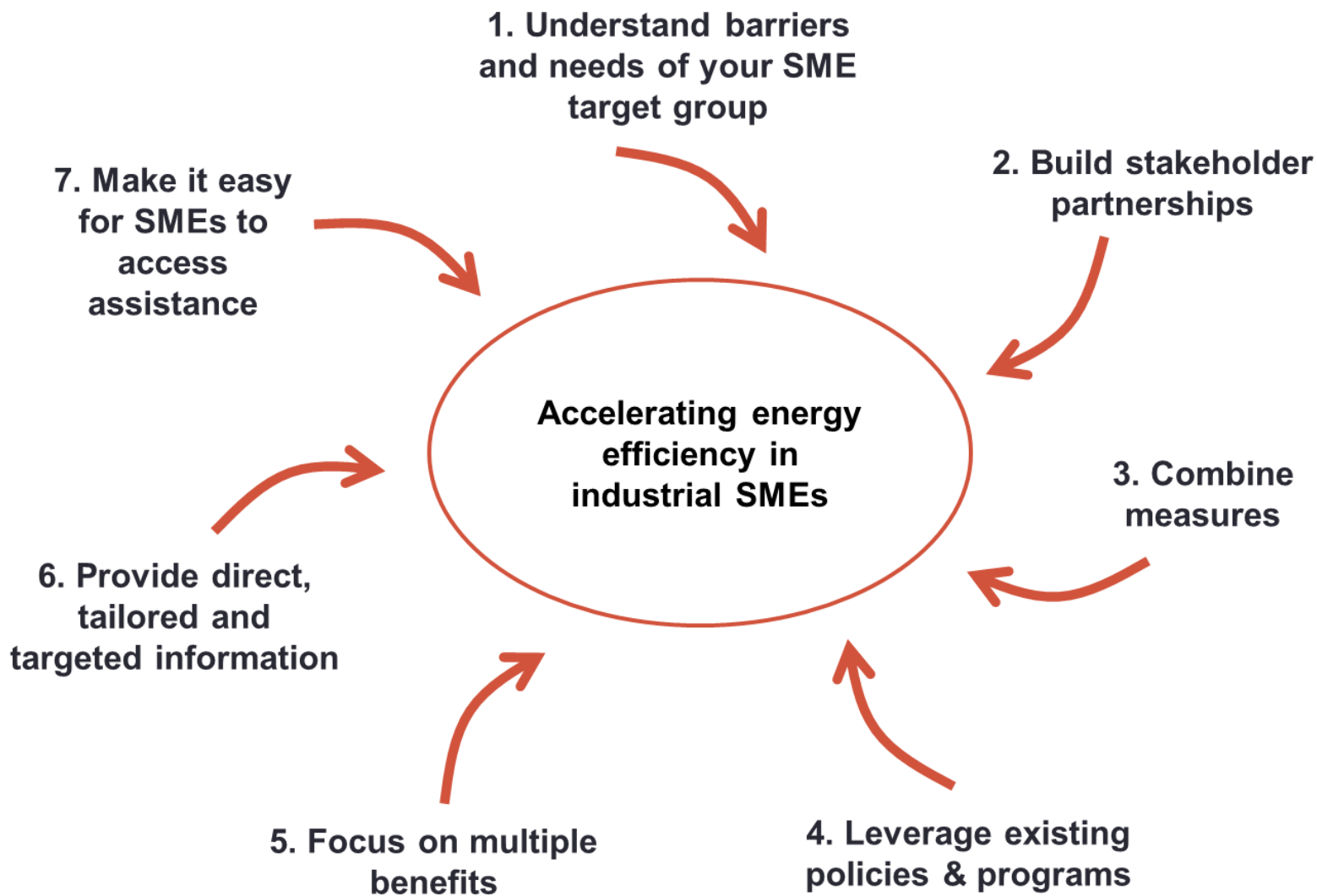


What is in a policy pathway on SMEs?



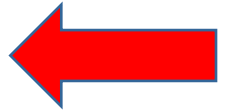
- Primarily considers SMEs in the industrial sector
- Structured set of steps and considerations that policy makers, programme managers and other practitioners can use to develop and review SME energy efficiency policies and programmes
- 20 + small case studies, 3 in-depth case studies
